Jul 6 2021 5:42PM Email received from comp on 7/6: "I live next to the house at 2708 N. Lacey St., which is a rental house, by a family with 3 kids and 2 dogs. The family went somewhere for a few days and left one of the dogs inside the house with no air conditioning. We heard it howling miserably for 2 days. Someone, a family member?, came last night and put the dog in the yard. When I put my cat out this morning she indicated that it was in the yard, so I looked to see if it was ok, and it was limping badly and wouldn't respond when I whistled or called it. It acted like it was deaf and couldn't see, and held its head down while limping around, which is not normal activity for this dog. It has always been aggressive when people or animals are near the fence, growling and jumping on the fence, but it has the stuffing knocked out of it now. It also appears to have lost some weight. I believe it could be severely dehydrated, and the injury could be making it worse. Please feel free to call me at 509-957-6378. I will keep my phone with me as I have today off and will be available all day. (My house is 2703 E. Buckeye Ave) If someone does go to investigate, check to see if the person who came to check on the dog is still there before approaching the dog. It has attacked other animals and people without provocation before. I don't think it has any interest in doing so now, it looks miserable, but caution should be applied. I'm just concerned whether the animal has food and water and whether the family knows of the injury. Their kids spend a lot of time visiting at the house at 2703 N Lacey, a brick house on the NW corner of Lacey and Buckeye. Maybe they know where the family went? And possibly can contact them. Thank you for your time." // NEG LIC.

General Vet Notes: 1/31/22: P older dog, has thin fur on hind legs/tail all appear rub alopecia/chronic condition. Biggest concern is oozing mass left flank approx 3inches diameter firm, movable mass, appears infected. This mass needs surgical resection and histopath to help decipher next steps. Small 2cm mass right hip ulcerated pink recommend removal of this mass as well. Plan to get P into surgery, start antibiotics today for infection. Various other older dog changes, nuclear sclerosis, stiff joints noted. - BOK

2/1/22: Sent off cbc - Pending. In house chemistry - WNL/normal. - BOK

2/3/22: CBC looks ok to proceed with surgery. P previously spayed and has tattoo. Mass removals Left flank and right hip both sent for histopathology. Suture removal in 2 weeks. - BOK

2/14/22: Histopathology results returned, both masses removed were low grade mast cell tumors that were completely excised with surgery! From report: "Both mast cell tumors have features to suggest they fall on the lower to intermediate end of the spectrum of grade 2 mast cell tumors. Based on the two tiered grading scheme these tumors are classified as low grade. As such, the complete excision achieved in this case will most likely be curative. However, some mast cell tumors can behave unpredictably and therefore, periodic evaluation of both sites for local recurrence and the regional lymph nodes for spread is recommended. The presence of more than one cutaneous mast cell tumor at the same time is not prognostic. Individual

histologic grade is more important." This is good news, no further actions besides monitoring need to take place at this time. Adopters need to be aware that this is an older dog that two mast cell tumors were removed, unlikely to reoccur but they could, she could also have more come up in other locations. At this time she does not appear to have other masses but will need to be monitored for any growths of concern. - BOK

2/17/22: Removed sutures from two mass removal sites. Incisions healed well. Noticed that P does have three small dermal lumps 1cm or less diameter left flank area, two are slightly red, one skin colored/black - these need to be closely monitored, if growing/changing recommend removal and histopath. This dog is prone to mast cell growths. P is ok to be adopted, adopters to be informed/medical waiver that they understand she had mast cells masses removed and that she may possibly have more in the future. The ones removed were low grade and per report fully excised. Monitor small bumps noted on left side as well as remainder of body for other growths and to get them checked out if arise. P is older dog that is in search of a good home to live out her life. - BOK

3/14/22: Drew blood - rechecking as P noted to be vomiting some. CBC/Chem pending. P lumps on left flank are getting a little larger and a few more small lumps are popping up... Suspect these are possible mast cells as well. Once bloodwork returns will make potential plan for possible surgery again, this was my concern that long term this would happen. - BOK

3/18/22: Chemistry indicates mild increase in SDMA, possible early kidney marker but other kidney values comparable to prior bloodwork. CBC few changes but nothing specific to disease process and no treatments needed. Bloodwork appears to be holding stable. Foster looking into possible rescue transfer, which would be great for this pup. Ideally she could benefit from full abdominal ultrasound to make sure she does not have any abdominal organs with mass cells, at this time not showing us any clinical disease. P small lumps left flank are growing, if have bandwidth and rescue opts not to pull will work on getting P back on surgery schedule for another revision mass removal surgery. If rescue does pull, recommend they follow up with their vet and make a plan for possible surgery vs monitoring. - BOK

3/28/22: Visually on walk thorough today, noticed masses left flank are getting larger in size/qty. Possible foster/hospice dog, needs good EOL/QOL care... will discuss with LS. - BOK

4/5/22: Masses in left flank continue to grow/multiply. Recommend fospice placement and monitor QOL, if masses continue to grow/open up get ulcerated need to evaluate. Due to rapid growth and current area, surgical intervention is not recommended and not an operable option now. - BOK

4/7/22: P leg in last few days has suddenly turned for the worse, severe edema, ulcerations and severe discomfort due to spreading neoplasia in left flank. Unable to keep P comfortable any longer and humane euthanasia recommended and performed. SQ telazol + ace, IV euth solution. No heart beat or corneal reflex. - BOK

Dogs with no clinical signs of hypothyroidism and results within the normal reference range are likely euthyroid. Dogs with low T4 concentrations may be hypothyroid or "euthyroid sick". Occasionally, hypothyroid dogs can have T4 concentrations that are low normal. Dogs with clinical signs of hypothyroidism and low or low normal T4 concentrations may be evaluated further by submission of freeT4 (fT4) and canine TSH. A high T4 concentration in a clinically normal dog is likely a variation of normal; however elevations may occur secondary to thyroid auto antibodies or rarely thyroid neoplasia. For dogs on thyroid supplement, acceptable 4-6 hour post pill total T4 concentrations generally fall within the higher end or slightly above the reference range.

SDMA:

SDMA and CREA within reference interval: impairment of GFR is unlikely. Recommended next step: evaluate complete urinalysis.

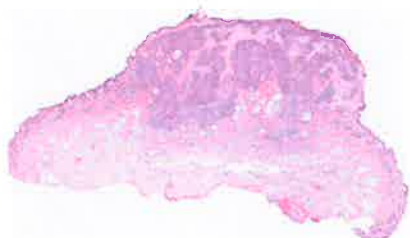

CASE COMMENT:

Both mast cell tumors have features to suggest they fall on the lower to intermediate end of the spectrum of grade 2 mast cell tumors. Based on the two tiered grading scheme these tumors are classified as low

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grade. As such, the complete excision achieved in this case will most likely be curative. However, some mast cell tumors can behave unpredictably and therefore, periodic evaluation of both sites for local recurrence and the regional lymph nodes for spread is recommended.

The presence of more than one cutaneous mast cell tumor at the same time is not prognostic. Individual histologic grade is more important.
