4/20/23: See emergency records, P has been declining in shelter, BEH QOL is declining. P more reactive to other dogs, seeking out other dog behavior evident, pupil dilation high FAS, spinning/pacing in kennel, weight loss and decreased appetite. Disassociation with people when in area, will seek for exit or other dogs and limited to no interaction with humans, turn/look/move away. P had her nose bit through kennel and move to E pod for healing/more quiet area. P is losing weight despite increased feeding. Going to have techs increase feeding even more and start on Trazodone BID to see if can improve her QOL any. Re-evaluate in 5-7 days to assess. - BOK

4/28/23: P nose is healing scaring is now present. Over the past week P has been being taken out multiple times a day, provided more enrichment, has inconsistently been willing to take medication, intermittently eating leaving some of her feedings in kennel un-eaten. 1 lb weight loss from last week, despite increased feed being offered. P continues to circle, pace in kennel, even when stimulus is removed continues to pace and takes >2minutes to settle and does not appear to truly settle, feigning sleep in kennel and minimal to no interaction with enrichment items in kennel or out. When removed from kennel continues in repetitive behavior of pacing. P was discussed for QOL concerns and declining mental state as well as physical decline with continued weight loss, risk factors associated with prior reported dog to dog aggression and continued dog reactivity at the Dog Team meeting on 4/28. As the ASV Guidelines for Standards of Care in Animal Shelters state "Any animal that is observed to be experiencing mental suffering, distress or behavioral deterioration must be assessed and appropriately treated in a timely manner or humanely euthanized. Just as a severe or rapid decline in an animal's physical health

constitutes an emergency situation and requires an urgent response, so do such changes in the behavioral or mental health of an animal." It was agreed upon that P QOL is suffering and is in constant mental distress that significant intervention is needed to help aid the deterioration of this P, over the last week with great efforts to continue to get P out multiple times and provide more enrichment and medication management P continued to be in a state of distress, at this time of discussion we had implemented changes within our resources and QOL was still suffering. No current rescue/transfer opening for a behavior/dog reactive case, it was decided that it is inhumane to continue to house and keep P in this state of distress and humane euthanasia was agreed upon.

What I am about to talk about should be prefaced with the agreement that once we make a feeding plan, it should be followed until the desired outcome is achieved and then reevaluated as needed. Additionally, failure to follow that plan is worthy of a reminder.

While it is true that the feeding instructions should be being followed, the assumption is that for a weight gain/loss diet is that it was necessary from the outset. This should include an evaluation of the animal's feeding habits, weight trends, and body condition score.

#### "Nancy (#41232) in B7 has continued to lose weight."

From the weight record we have in shelter buddy, this appears to be true. This dog came in at 80 lbs about a year ago and now weighs around 74 lbs.

#### "She has lost over 1 lb since being weighed in January."

Again, from the records we have, this also appears to be the case. She has gone from 75 lbs to 74 lbs over the course of 4 months.

# "I have noticed several days that she is not being fed wet food still. I know we are on short supply, but Nancy NEEDS to be fed a good amount of wet food, otherwise she will continue to flip her bowl upside down and refuse to eat it."

I have seen, on occasion, full bowls of just kibble or 90% kibble in her kennel, so I do not doubt this. As I often am the one taking care of B Pod in the morning, on the occasion that she has been given just kibble, in the morning, I find either the bowl still mostly full or it spilled all over the floor.

# "I will be adding a special diet to the front and back of her kennel if she doesn't already have one to remind everyone."

As we have determined that the dog is on a special diet of sorts, I see no issues here and appreciate you doing so.

Now....

While I agree with the things you have said in this e-mail, there are implications in what you have

said that I disagree with.

Nancy came in last year weighing about 80 lbs. She now weighs around 74 lbs. A 6 pound loss might be concerning IF that loss meant the dog's BCS was dropping to an unhealthy level. However, I am of the opinion that, right now, her BCS is a 4 at the worst and lean more towards her being at a 5, either one being ideal. The main differentiation from a 3 to a 4 is the visible spine and, to a lesser extent, ribs. This morning, neither were visible to me so I do not believe she would be categorized as too thin. The fat on the ribs is the main differentiation between a 4 and a 5 and I am less confident on that distinction, but could easily understand someone calling her a 5.

The implication of saying Nancy is continuing to lose weight is that it is a bad thing, but I do not believe this to be the case. From my perspective, over the course of 4 months, a 75 lbs dog lost 1 lb and is at a near ideal BCS. For a 75 lbs dog, that can literally be a bowel movement. That tells me that, in general, we have been doing a good job in terms of feeding and to keep up the good work. We can certainly keep an eye out to make sure is isn't a *very* gradual trend downwards and the feeding chart is a good reminder for that.

I'm going to assume you are looking at this from the perspective of, "this dog has already lost 5 pounds and is continuing to lose more in spite of our additional feedings", but that would only be bad if the dog's ideal weight was 80 lbs in the first place. Given that I think she is at a good BCS score now at around 75 lbs, I believe 80 lbs would getting into a 6 or possibly 7 and so I would disagree that we should be trying to fatten the dog back up to 80 lbs.

While I don't think there was anything untrue about what you said in your e-mail, I am worried about the underlying information the diet was based on, chiefly the dog's BCS.

#### TLDR:

- People should be following feeding instructions and if they are not, reminders are warranted.
- I think Nancy is at a near perfect weight right now and the urgency implied in your e-mail is not offensive but perhaps overstated.
- If that is the case, the current feedings are working well, even considering someone occasionally feeding just kibble.
- We may have a disconnect is terms of BCS evaluation which we should correct if so.

We can talk about this whenever we're here together if you'd like. I don't have an issue with the email, it just brought to my attention the broad idea of an animal losing weight isn't necessarily bad and Nancy is a good candidate to have that discussion about. I'm sure you share my sentiment that if the root misunderstanding is one of us is incorrectly evaluating BCS, we should figure that out.

#### Hello,

I know we have our dog team meeting tomorrow, but wanted to send this email so that we could all ruminate prior. I am asking for another week extension for Nancy and Domino. We just started trying new methods this week that appear to have positive effects so far.

Stephanie placed an impact crate inside Domino's kennel on Tuesday and he has had half his body inside. He has been spending more time at the front of the kennel, as people are less scary than the crate currently. He also wasn't consistently taking his medication, so we'd like to see if the meds have any further effects after one more week.

Ashley started walking Nancy yesterday and took her walking outside the shelter perimeter today. Nancy was sniffing around in the field today and played ball outside in the play yard for a bit. Ashley has offered to walk her longer every morning for the next week to see if the extra exercise counters the kennel stress. She also wants to take her for an offsite field trip next week to see if that engages Nancy's interest. Ashley also posted a foster request for Nancy today, so we'd like to give time to see if any interest comes forth.

Stephanie and I created a free work area in Jesse's office today for sensory play. We had Ragamuffin in there first and he had fun exploring the different stations and searching out treats. Nancy came in next and was only interested in the cheese that was easy to get too, but was uninterested in exploring any of the stations. However, she sought out attention from Ashley, Stephanie, Joe and I and laid down in the community room and hung out. Nancy then went up into the APO office and relaxed in Ashley's office for a while. Joe took her out again later today and she laid in the small play yard with relaxed posture and periodic happy tail wags.

I know we are concerned about QOL for these two dogs, but I believe that giving these dogs another week to better evaluate the recent progress would be beneficial and give us more information in order to accurately assess them. I think we can all agree that we owe these dogs time, if there are lifesaving alternatives.

3/21/23: P is older, suspect spayed female (scar ventral midline). Has large soft nonpainful mass right flank - dfdx: lipoma, has mass ventral abdomen inside leg, soft movable in SQ palpate fat like as well. Monitor lumps, location and size with P age removal is not in best interest at this time. P has urine soiling across hind end/legs - suspect possibly incontinent vs laying in urine (kennel was soiled though when took P out). Need to collect Urine sample - pending. In house chemistry overall looks decent, mild increase in ALP which is common with age. Arthritis in joint, stiff and decreased ROM. Moderate dental disease needs dental care. Senior dog with a multitude of medial concerns. Plan: urinalysis pending. Once get evaluation on urine and move to individual kennel to monitor/confirm leaking, will make further medical plan. If reclaimed VTN. - BOK

4/4/23 Vomiting and diarrhea last couple of days. No vomiting today. BAR, well hydrated, very nervous with handling. Started her on metronidazole 250 mg PO BID x 7d, monitor hydration. CB

4/13/23: Unable to catch urine have tried multiple times, P has not been leaking or wet and appears to have control of bladder now that able to observe in individual kennel. Rx clavamox for suspected UTI. - BOK

4/24/23: Besides prior masses that are being monitored, P appears to be stable senior dog. Urination appears normal, has finished tx for suspected UTI. No ongoing treatments at this time. Is senior dog with dental disease, needs routine dental care still, on list for possible dental if appointments open up. Ok for adoption with medical waiver for senior dog. – BOK

\*As of today she has been eating and elimination normal, no vomiting and has not been soiling herself. UTI resolved and is just awaiting a loving home for a senior pup.

Let me know what other questions you might have and happy to follow up with you when you are here. She came in with another younger heeler and she has been social with other dogs and no concerns when handling her for medical besides she does not like to pee on command.

Last week we spoke about making sure the dogs your receive have a documented history of behavior and that you are aware in the event you were questioned about it by your insurance.

Today we spoke about all the dogs you intend to take and some history. They are as follow:

52945- Blue – Clear – Possible bite reported by finder. No victim came forward but good to have the FYI. You said that it would be fine.

53587- Toby - Clear

53448- Quincy – Clear. We spoke about his return feedback that you couldn't recall. Sounds like just a bit of food aggression.

54757- Tessa - Clear

44017- Mystery – Clear. We lack a lot of documentation on this girl. She has made leaps and bounds recently. I think shes a good candidate for transfer.

43802- Mango – Clear (If it doesn't work, please contact furry farm rescue. They were interested and could help in the event that you feel that you have extended your resources.) We discussed that you had evaluated this dog the last time you were in and that you had passed then. You are very happy with his progress and want to take him. YAY! 50802- Jezebel - Clear

52044- Astrid – Can't take here. She may have an adopter. 2<sup>nd</sup> appointment Tuesday the 2<sup>nd</sup>

54141- Willow – Clear

41231- Sid – Cleared with full review of documented history. From your feedback, you knew about the attack on a cat but Sid does have a bit more documented behaviors. Sounds like just animal aggression. I have some positive things to say about this guy but just to make sure that you and your organization are successful, Id like you to review his whole history before taking him.
