General Vet Notes: 6/7/22: P is BAR, is slow to rise in hind end suspect some arthritis but hips/stifles actually palpate pretty good. Could be low back arthritis as well. MM Pink, moist, CRT <2sec, mild tartar but teeth worn down - P has likely been a chewer in the past. Ears mild waxy. Eyes mature nuclear sclerosis OU - normal aging change. P has mass right neck 5cm diameter firm, movable nonpainful - Rec removal and histopath of this mass if not reclaimed. If reclaimed 2 week VTN. Abdomen tense nonpainful. Overall P in decent shape for older neutered male. Monitor and report any daily concerns. Will re-evaluate once off hold and draw blood for potential surgery scheduling. - BOK

6/16/22: In house chem/lytes normal no concerns. Ok for mass removal surgery if have space on schedule, in mean time please monitor lump if changing or concerns arise please put in care request. IF adopters willing to adopt dog with lump and monitor/care for it, ok to adopt with medical waiver. - BOK

6/22-7/7/22: P was not eating well on adoption floor. Moved to E pod for closer observation/monitoring. Had techs start feeding wet food, P took well to that and increased appetite. P BAR, friendly in kennel. Periodic foamy vomit. Had not been showing any major symptoms or changes, plan to try to reach out to rescue partners for old dog haven as suspect P does not have super long, appears to be up and down but no overt treatable symptoms at this time and still wants to get up and eat his soft food.

7/8/22: Unassisted death, found curled up on bed passed away. Suspect passed in his sleep, geriatric dog. - BOK

Dogs with no clinical signs of hypothyroidism and results within the normal reference range are likely euthyroid. Dogs with low T4 concentrations may be hypothyroid or "euthyroid sick". Occasionally, hypothyroid dogs can have T4 concentrations that are low normal. Dogs with clinical signs of hypothyroidism and low or low normal T4 concentrations may be evaluated further by submission of freeT4 (fT4) and canine TSH. A high T4 concentration in a clinically normal dog is likely a variation of normal, however elevations may occur secondary to thyroid auto antibodies or rarely thyroid neoplasia. For dogs on thyroid supplement, acceptable 4-6 hour post pill total T4 concentrations generally fall within the higher end or slightly above the reference range.

SDMA:

SDMA and CREA within reference interval; impairment of GFR is unlikely. Recommended next step: evaluate complete urinalysis.
