Prince (#55094) 5/10/23 Greets friendly at front of kennel with licks and curved body. Tail tucked, shake off within 10 seconds or less. then loose tail wags. Leashed easily with slip lead and did not forcefully exit kennel. Tail tucked and cowering low to the ground for beginning of walk and jumped on handler for assistance. After 60 seconds musculature loosened, less cowering, and tail came to baseline. Leash Manners: Pulls lightly. Did not grab leash with mouth during walk, but did so in the play yard. Traded for toy. Personality scores: Friendliness 25/34 Fearfulness 2/36 Excitability 14/33 Playfulness 9/21 Trainability 9/15 Total Behavioral Triage Score: 10/25* Prince is suitable for adoption with behavior modification. Recommended behavioral training for jumping/mouthing. *Prince and Nala were brought in from a home where one, or both, attacked a kitten that resulted in death. Nala had scratches, puncture wounds, and blood present at examination. Prince did not. SCRAPS was unable to verify with certainty which dog attacked. Prince scores a 10 on behavioral triage if the attack is removed from his behavioral history.*
