- **Speech: (Queen Contestants only) points are granted for the content, originality and delivery of the contestant’s speech.
- ** Impromptu Questions: points are granted for correctness of the answer, creativity and the ability to communicate.
- **Contestants in this pageant are to wear two Western outfits, one for personal interview, speech and impromptu to Pageant Luncheon (time and place to be announced) and other outfit for Horsemanship that afternoon.
- ** Horsemanship: July 7th, CJM Country Stables Arena will follow the Luncheon. 2 Easy Western Patterns, 1 Queen Run, Flag Run and Horsemanship continuation: July 20th Friday Night Bash, with Flag Run, Queen Run around the arena. The contestant’s horse tack and saddle pads should be color coordinated with outfits.
- Each contestant will introduce themselves to spectators on mic and little Interview (for example “What is your favorite Rodeo Event?”) with Rodeo Announcer.
- ** Personality and Appearance and Aloha Spirt during Fridays’ Slack and Friday Night Bash-points will be given as contestant demonstrates her ability to greet and converse with spectators, contestants and sponsors.
- **All of the contestants to ride in Saturday and Sunday’s Rodeo Grand Entries and will be introduced; the winners will be announced during Saturday’s Rodeo intermission. All contestants are invited to ride in the following weekend parade with CJM’s mounted unit.
- **Sunday’s Rodeo Queen, Princess & Jr. Princess will be introduced during the Grand Entry at 11:00. You will be the Rodeo’s Ambassadors during the rodeo & will be presenting the awards to rodeo’s winners at the end of Rodeo, that will be photographed and videoed.
- ** Each contestant is required to sell a minimum of 25 rodeo tickets to participate in pageant. All contestants must turn in money from their ticket sales by July 7th (day of Horsemanship and Luncheon): All contestants can sell additional tickets up to week before the Rodeo and receive \$1.00 per ticket
- ** Awards: Each contestant will be receiving a gift bag. Awards (gifts) will be giving in each category: **Appearance, Horsemanship and Personality** for each division. The Queen, Princess and Jr. Princess will receive a rodeo sash and Cowboy hat tiara and addition gifts depending on availability sponsors.
