Essential Functions:

- (1) Biosolids disposal: Remove biosolids and liquid sludge from BCWS Water Reclamation Facilities; transfer to the appropriate sludge disposal facility; clean and maintain sludge trucks, sludge storage areas and sludge handling equipment.
- (2) Record Keeping: Completing and maintaining scale tickets, completing and maintaining liquid sludge log, data base entry for landfill liquid hauling and mowing.
- (3) Perform other duties as required. Duties may include assisting other departments as needed.
- (4) Meet all job safety requirements and all applicable OSHA safety standards that pertain to essential functions.

Required Qualifications:

Must possess a valid Ohio driver’s license. A CDL (Class “A” with tanker and 5th wheel endorsement) is required. Must be able to operate dump trucks, tanker truck, front end loader, tractor trailer and other equipment as needed. Must be able to comply with all standard operating procedures. A high school degree or equivalent is required. The Biosolids Specialist II must be in good physical condition and be able to withstand adverse conditions that may occur (i.e. bouncing around, climbing up and down, etc). Works outside in all weather conditions.
