ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Water Line Repairs, 30% of the time

Perform unskilled, semi-skilled and skilled tasks for installation and repair of water distribution system components, (e.g. installation of water service lines and mains, repair of watermain breaks, installation of taps into system, repair of fire hydrants, assist with repair of motors and pumps, etc.); repair meters, (e.g., disassemble, treat with chemical solution and repair or replace worn or defective parts; and assist with sewer line problems and sewer backups, etc.

Equipment Operation, 25% of the time

Operate various heavy equipment (e.g., backhoe, loader, sewer jet, jack hammer and dump truck) and small equipment (bobcat, leak detection and watermain locators).

Section Leading, 20% of the time

Serve as acting supervisor as necessary; represent section on various committees; lead crew in the performance of daily activities by supervising the job site; instruct personnel on the proper use of equipment; provide training on specific procedures that are performed by Water Line Maintenance employees; assure that all work is done in a safe manner; and is responsible for successful completion of job in accordance with Section and Department procedures, OEPA requirements, and applicable mandates.

Hydrant Work, 10% of the time

Perform preventive maintenance on hydrants; and repair and replace broken hydrants.

Maintenance, 5% of the time

Perform shop and equipment maintenance including daily greasing of equipment, housekeeping, tool and supply care, inventory ordering, and yard restorations.

Other Duties as Required, 10% of the time

Perform other duties as required.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must have a high school education or the equivalent thereof. Must have a valid Ohio driver's license with a Class A CDL and tanker endorsement. Must have the ability to engage in manual labor over extended periods of time under varied field conditions and the willingness to respond to after-hours emergency situations.
