- Regulatory Compliance
 - Meeting all water quality standards
 - Your public deserves it
 - EPA demands it
 - Your Certification depends on it
 - Review your facilities with compliance in mind
 - Ask yourself: “What can I do to make it better”
 - Best Practices

It's all a Part of a Compliance Program

- Regulatory compliance
 - Have a violation reporting protocol
 - ✓ To EPA
 - ✓ To your consumers
 - ✓ To the news media
- Safety compliance
 - Conduct a hazard analysis on each task
 - Go home safe to your family every night

- Asset management
- Security plan
 - Know and identify what your security risks are

The Alternative to Compliance

- What happens when compliance does not happen
 - Violations
 - Loss of public confidence
 - Environmental hazards
 - Fines
 - Loss of Certification
 - Jail time

Safety Compliance

- What happens when safety compliance is ignored
 - Near misses
 - Injury
 - Lost wages
 - Increased insurance costs
 - Production downtime
 - Liability issues

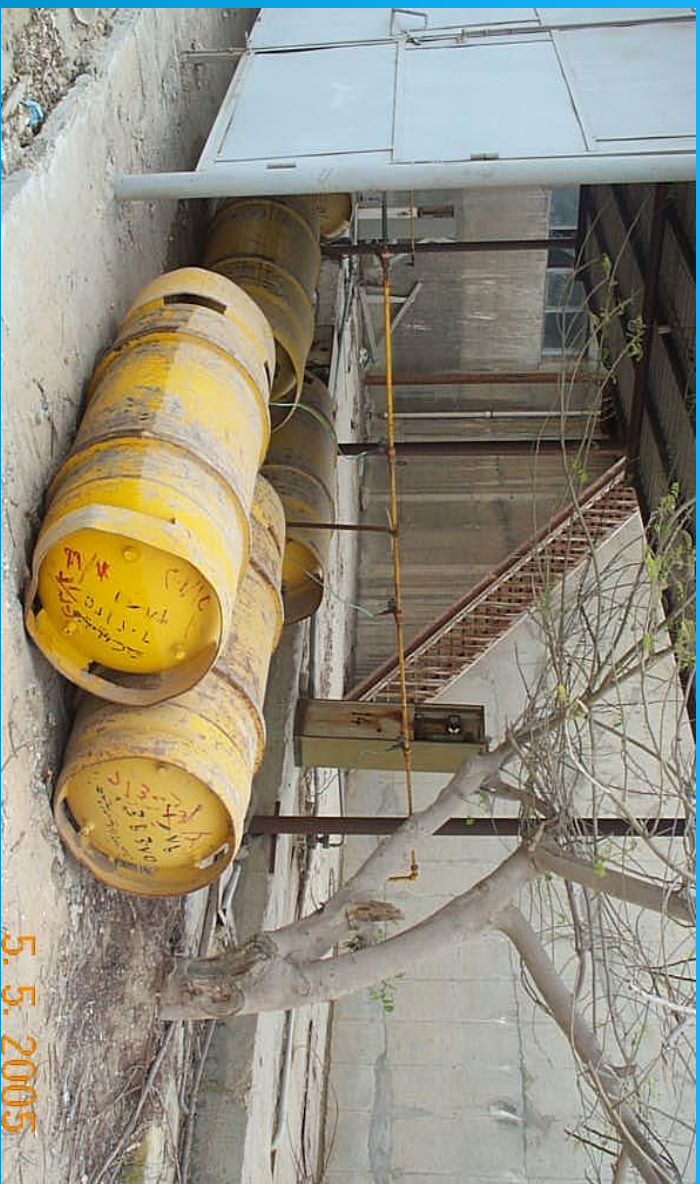
