RULE MAKING



Rule	Effective Changes
Various	Operators will be referred to as Professional Operators
3745-07-01	Laboratory, Pretreatment, and Engineering Experience restrictions Only if the experience is solely in these types of positions.
	Collection and Distribution Experience restrictions Only if applying for a treatment certificate.
	Adding the definition of "Week" "Week" – Sunday to Saturday
3745-07-02	Contracted professional operators shall perform their duties in accordance with the contract operator rule
	Contract must clearly define the responsibilities of the owner and the professional operator

3745-07-03	Distribution System staffing requirements Class $1-3$ days, Class $2-5$ days Visit is defined as "a period of time when a person is on-site at a public water system, treatment works, or sewerage system that is sufficient to perform routine sampling, maintenance or observation of a public water system, sewerage systems, or treatment works in order to ensure compliance and proper operation."

3745-07-21 Contract Operations Companies and Contracted Professional Operators

- Are you a contract operator?
- Requires registration for all contract operators and contract operation companies.
- Seven requirements for minimum expectations for contracts with facilities must address:
 - Operation of the facility
 - Minimum staffing hours
 - Emergency operations
 - Maintenance (routine and preventative)
 - Ensuring the operators comply with the responsibilities of a professional operator in accordance with this chapter.
 - Sharing of correspondence from agency between both owner and contracted professional operator.
 - Conducting all sampling for the facility.

- The sample contract is a SAMPLE.
- Only one representative sample which meets the requirements of the rule.
- June 30th of each year a form will be required which identifies which plants a contract operator or operating company is operating.

Common Questions on New Rules

The collection/distribution system is under a different department. How do I handle reporting collection system visits as the plant ORC?

Does the ORC of the collection/distribution system have to be the one who makes the visits?

Our NPDES permit states we don't have to meet minimum staffing for collection systems. Does that mean we don't have to follow the new requirements?



Common Questions on New Rules

We have several ORCs who may be on duty during a single day. How do we enter that?

How do I account for times I leave the plant?

When are we required to start reporting our staffing?

Can you develop a separate form that we can use instead of reporting on the eDMR/eDWR?





Electronic Renewals available August 1st

What courses are accessible on eBusiness?

- All courses are available
- Most attendance is uploaded
- Operators can upload their own course/contact hour information <u>after August 1st</u> of renewal year



2018 renewals must go through the eBusiness Center.

Easy to submit!
Almost 85% of all operators due to renew in 2018 have already been processed.

Contact Hours are already listed in your operator service.

Turn around time on renewal applications:

- About a week, if payment is made online.
- A few weeks, if payment is made via mail.
- Processing time significantly decreased.


