Applicants must possess a high school diploma or equivalent, a Class II Water Distribution License from the Ohio EPA, and a valid Class A commercial driver's license (CDL) or ability to obtain within the first 90 days of employment. This is a bargaining-unit, non-exempt position. The pay range is \$23.27 - \$32.21/hour, dependent on licensure, qualifications, and experience, plus a benefits package which includes participation in the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS). POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Title: TROUBLESHOOTER 2

This position reports to the Operations and Maintenance Manager and involves the performance of various functions involving the operation, maintenance, repair and modification of the District's water system or other infrastructure of the District. Duties include troubleshooting and analysis of complex mechanical, electrical and electronic equipment. The primary functions within this category involve working independently or as a member of a construction/maintenance team, consisting of two or more employees, to perform various tasks.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Ability to operate the District's treatment and pumping facilities;
- Ability to operate, repair and maintain the District's treatment plants, booster stations, pressure reducing stations, water storage tanks and office facilities;
- Maintain monitoring and control telemetry;
- Prepare and maintain accurate maintenance records and work order history;
- Solve Complex problems to ensure system operations;
- Perform duties in a safe and efficient manner, in compliance with all regulatory requirements and District policies; and
- New and other related duties as assigned.

OTHER JOB FUNCTIONS:

Although Troubleshooters typically perform their duties five days per week, all employees within this position must be available for off-hours on-call duty to respond to emergency call-outs on a 24 hour per day, 7-day per week basis. Such duty is rotated and/or as assigned, among classification employees. Must be able to perform tasks involving stooping, bending, twisting and unassisted carrying and lifting of materials or tools, operating/using various types of construction equipment and tools, and working within restricted spaces and on varying terrain. The ability to work outdoors in adverse weather conditions is also required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Good communication and organizational skills, the ability to work independently, and the ability to direct others;
2. Possession of valid Class II Ohio EPA Water Distribution license;
3. Valid Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL);

4. Completion of Electrical Safety Training;
5. High School Diploma or GED;
6. This position is a Level 3 Emergency Responder

The position is included within a collective bargaining unit for which the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 20, is the exclusive bargaining agent. Each employee is subject to the terms of the Bargaining Unit Agreement.
