

PLANT OPERATOR LABORER

The City of West Carrollton, OH (pop. 13,143) is accepting applications for the position of **Plant Operator Laborer (PO)**. The PO is responsible for a wide range of general operational and maintenance activities associated with the water and sewer treatment plants.

Required Qualifications at Time of Application: Applicants **must possess** a valid driver's license and have a high school diploma or GED.

Obtained Qualifications Within Six (6) Months of Employment: Applicants **must obtain** a State of Ohio EPA Chemical Certification for pH and Chlorine within six months of employment.

Obtained Certificates: Applicants progress to the PO I, PO II, and PO III positions based on satisfactory performance reviews and obtaining Ohio EPA Water Supply Operator and OEPA Wastewater Works Operator certificates. It is desired that the successful applicant **obtains** both a Water Supply Class I and a Wastewater Works Class I certificate within three (3) years of employment.

The successful candidate must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screening and fitness for duty exam. The finalist offer will also be conditional upon the results of a thorough background investigation. Minority and female candidates are encouraged to apply/EOE.
