Completions

- 16-26-72-7W6M new pad (TWP 730 RR 71) Well frac is complete and the well is presently being flow tested.
- 16-8-72-7W6M new pad (Grandview Rd & TWP 722) One Well completion is planned for February 2, 2020. Water for completion is being sourced from Bear Lake.

Pipeline/Facilities

- Pipeline 16-8-72-7W6M (Grandview Rd. & TWP 722) to 1-14-72-8W6M (TWP 722 RR 81). Pad site on 16-8 will be completed in Q1 of 2020. Kelts intends to build approximately 5km of pipeline to tie this well into its existing 1-14 Battery. Pipeline is presently in the consultation and acquisition phase with construction slated for late January 2020.
- Pipeline 14-29-74-8W6M (RR 85 and Hiway 59) to 11-31-73-8W6M (RR 85 and TWP 735) Pipeline intended to connect Kelt La Glace production to Tidewater Pipeline then onto Pipestone plant. Project is in consultation/acquisition phase with construction to commence in later January to early February.

Tidewater

- We continue to strive to reduce flaring at the Pipestone gas plant with ongoing process improvements and changes.
- There is a planned plant outage late in the first quarter of 2020 for maintenance, we have not determined the exact date as of this time. This recent cold weather is impacting the operations.
- Pembina has completed construction on their metering station within Pipestone Plant site. It will be brought
 online in Mid-February when Pembina's liquid pipelines are tied into Tidewater's facility. Trucking of their current
 volumes will continue until this work is completed.
- We are not forecasting any wellsite work in January.

- Drilling

 - o Pipeline 12-3-73-8W6M (Hiway #724 & Emerson Trail) to 14-2-73-8W6M (TWP 730 & RR 82) to 1-14-72-8W6M (TWP 722 & RR81) Mainline construction of pipelines complete. On lease tie-ins are being worked on and will soon be completed. Some right of way was restored but due to weather final clean up and restoration will be done spring 2020.

• We have completed the groundwork on our new oil battery site at 01-20-72-08W6. This is located 1 mile south of TWP RD 724 on RR84. This project has been pushed into 2021. Pipelines and facility work will be pushed to Q4 2020.

Tidewater Midstream

- 12-35-70-9W6 gas plant now fully operational. Minimizing the frequency of flaring, and plant upsets continues to be a top priority for the operations team.
- Fluid hauling from Pipestone Plant site using RR92 continues. Pembina liquids pipelines delivering product from plant now expected to be complete in January.
- Pipeline Construction now underway from sec 17-72-8 to sec 31-73-8w6. Completion end 2019 to early January.

Pipestone Energy Corp.

- Drilling:
 - o SW (LSD 6) 24-71-8-W6M padsite for 6 wells.
 - Location: ½ mile south of Highway 43 on Rge. Rd. 81
 - Drilling well 5 of 6 on this pad.
 - o SW (LSD 6) 30-71-7-W6M padsite for 6 wells
 - Location ½ mile north of highway 43 on Rge. Rd. 80
 - Plan to drill a 6 well pad from December 2019 to February 2020.

 - This Padsite is pipeline connected which will allow Pipestone to test these wells through the recently installed pipeline resulting in no planned flaring.
- Pipeline Work:
 - o Main construction for the Pipestone pipelines 15-14-70-8- to 6-30-71-8-W6M is complete however due to rain the freshwater liner has not been installed and right of way cleanup is still required. Liner installation for the northern half of the freshwater pipeline will commence in mid-October. The southern portion to be completed after frozen ground conditions. The right of way cleanup will be completed next spring.
 - o Pipeline Location: 9-14-71-7-W6M to 5-14-71-7-W6M
 - Rge. Rd. 71, 1.5 miles south of Highway 43 on Spring Creek Road

- o Pipeline construction and installation is expected to commence in Mid-November and run through to January 2020. Once work is completed this will allow Pipestone to test these wells in line resulting in no planned flaring.
- Installed Wellsite facilities:
 - o 15-14-70-8-W6M Pad
 - Location north of TWP road 702, RR 81A
 - Production started September 2019 flowing to Keyera compressor site at 8-15-70-8-W6M
 - o 3-1-71-8-W6M Pad
 - Location off TWP road 710 just west of RR 80
 - Production started September 2019. Flowing to both the Keyera Wapiti Plant at 3-19-67-7W6 (South of the Wapiti river) and the Tidewater Plant at 12-35-70-9-W6M (SW of Wembly)
 - o 6-24-71-8-W6M Pad
 - Location: ½ mile south of Highway 43 on Rge. Rd. 81
 - Installed wellsite equipment for production for 1 well. Well commenced production in October 2019.

Advantage Oil & Gas

- o Construction on 3-1-73-8 battery is continuing. Currently gravelling site. Piles to start right away. Weather dependant. Corner of RR 81 & TWP RD 730
- o Completions on the 14-19-72-7 pad is ongoing. Fraccing is complete. Flowbacks to start on November 9th. Gas is flowing to Tidewater. Fluids will be trucked. RR 75A and TWP RD 724
- o Completions on 3-1-73-8 Pad will start in the beginning of January. Water is being taken from Bear Lake. TDL 00451210. Flat line hoses will pump water from Bear lake to 3-25-72-8. RR 81 & TWP RD 724. Water will then be pumped down our pipeline to 3-1-73-8.
