John Hartford

- Not much to update from Advantage Oil & Gas. We are not drilling/completing/or pipelining.

Tidewater Midstream Update

Chris Walsh, Stakeholder, Community & Indigenous Relations

- Plant operations steady with overall plant uptime at 96%.
- Onsite equipment repairs were completed between June 24 and 30.
- Planned plant outages for upgrades are scheduled for late August
- All Tidewater area pipelines are commissioned and operational. Planning for Right of way cleanup
 this summer is underway, weather pending clean up scheduled to begin the third or fourth week
 of July
- We are not forecasting any wellsite work in July.
- There are only a few trucks per day hauling condensate into the plant on RR92.
- 2 to 3 trucks per day hauling Produced water away from the plant.

 - o Pad Location: 9-14-71-7-W6M
 - Rge. Rd. 71, 1.5 miles south of Highway 43 on Spring Creek Road

 - Location ½ mile north of highway 43 on Rge. Rd. 80
- Facility construction work has been complete by mid-July

- No new changes or development for Husky.
- 13-26-72-10 multi-well pad and 4-25 well site are on production to Tidewater Pipestone Plant. Pipeline internal inspection work was completed in June on HMGP main flowline.
- Development: 7-11 pad work has been completed for 2020 3 wells drilled, production scheduled for 2021, project planning in process. 11-17 pad (2 wells) & 15-33 well site are on production.

TC Energy

Cole Thomson, MA, G. Dipl. SR&S Public Affairs – Canada West

- Riverbend Pipeline Project
 - o We continue to work with our commercial partner on plans for the pipeline.
 - o An update to WASP will be provided when we have more information to provide.
- 2021 NGTL System Expansion Project
 - o We are awaiting necessary federal approvals from our Governor in Council and the Canada Energy Regulator.

- o We will notify WASP when we have further updates on Project timing and what the community can expect during construction.
- Clearwater West Expansion Project
 - o Clean up activities continue now that the Huallen Pipeline Section is in service.
- Grande Prairie Mainline Loop No. 4 Valhalla North Pipeline Section
 - o We anticipate sending Project updates to our stakeholders and landowners later this month.

• We are completed the cleanup on our pipeline right away from our La Glace facility to our 12-35 well site and expecting this to be complete Aug 15th, 2020.

Keyera Update

Vanessa Cartwright, Community Relations

Project updates:

- Keyera, along with its partner, SemCams Midstream ULC, has deferred construction of the KAPS Pipeline for one year. This deferral was announced in May 2020.
- The North Wapiti Pipeline, Crude Pipeline, SWD Pipeline and Gold Creek Lateral ROW assessment was completed in June with final ROW clean-up occurring in July.
- Expansion of the Keyera Pipestone Compressor Station (SE-15-70-8-W6) is underway Primary work, installation of 3rd inlet compressor, to commence late July, to be operational mid to late October
- Phase 2 expansion of the Wapiti gas plant —Construction is complete and commissioning is underway. Done in stages by process unit, this work is expected to be complete by October.
- Sour Water Disposal pipeline (a new 4.15 kilometer, 8-inch, Produced Water pipeline, to be constructed from Keyera's existing water disposal wellsite (4-6-66-6 W6M) to a new water disposal well located at 15-8-66-6 W6M) construction deferred to winter of 2021/2022.
- Tie ins to North Wapiti Pipeline (October) and pipeline from Gold Creek being scheduled to coincide with facility shutdowns for other purposes

Community investment:

- Keyera has been supporting our communities through the covid-19 pandemic in a variety of ways, including:
 - o Individual acts of kindness by Keyera employees to help their communities, from making face masks to fundraising for those in need;
 - Giving back to our communities and supporting 15 organizations that support front line workers, and address food scarcity and accommodation needs in Alberta, Oklahoma and Texas; and
 - o Supporting the most vulnerable and providing over \$80,000 to women's emergency shelters in our Alberta operating areas including Calgary, Rocky Mountain House, Grande Prairie and Edmonton.

(South of TWP 724 and RR90)

- 2 Rigs drilling expecting to be done mid- August
- Completions activity beginning mid-August

• Construction complete from the compressor at 15-30-72-8 to 14-30-71-8 o Cleanups to start in August

• Construction underway and expected to be complete in July/August as delayed by rains

Sweet Gas Tie in 5-7-73-8 to 15-12-73-9

• Construction complete – cleanups to follow in the summer

Pipestone Processing Disposal Line 4-7-73-8 to 9-21-73-8

• Construction underway and expected to be complete in July

Pipestone Processing Facility

(RR 90 South of Emerson highway)

• Construction ongoing until Q3

Bush Lake

• Ovintiv has applied for and received a TDL from the Regulator to withdraw water from October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. This is after Trumpeter swan timing.

County of Grande Prairie Road Bonds

• Ovintiv's 2020 Road Bonds are complete, and roads have been inspected by the County.
