
Role of Energy Industry Chair

SLM Program Status

- Given the ongoing downturn in Industry, the SLM program has continued to experience low enrollment numbers.
- In fall 2019, OC decided to suspend first year student intake for fall 2020.
- OC commenced a program review process in conjunction with other programs at OC.
- OC will be engaging with Industry to ensure valuable feedback on program delivery & industry trends are gathered.

SLM Program Status

- Should changes be required to SLM, it will take at least until 2021 to implement such changes
- SLM currently has 1st year and 2nd year students enrolled in SLM who will be graduating in 2020 & 2021.
- OC will continue to work with SLM Industry Advisory Committee & Energy Industry Chair throughout process.
- SLM will be hosting our annual Industry Reception on March 19 in Calgary
