

Slow Play “Cheat Sheet”

Record Your Start Time on Your Scorecard - look at the time on your phone or watch and note the exact time your group actually started to Tee Off on Your 1st Hole - **RECORD THAT TIME.**

A group is out of position when:

1. It is over the allocated time for the holes that have been played

USE ACTUAL TIME AS A MEASURE: Regardless of what course you are playing, the estimated time to play a hole is no more than **15 minutes.**

1 Hour After You Tee Off Your Group should be on the tee box or already playing your 5th Hole!

(This is especially a good method to check your pace if you are in the B group and the A group is playing very quickly - be aware of your time)

2. USE YOUR POSITION IN RELATION TO GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU.

Not in position with the previous group? When to know you are in trouble:

- The group is more than the starting interval behind the group in front of them.
- A par 4 or par 5 hole is **open** before the group reaches the teeing area of that hole.
