Swimming Pool Rules & Regulations (2020 Season)

- The pool and deck are for exclusive use of Greene homeowners and residents
 whose dues are current. Homeowners whose dues are delinquent for two or more
 months will have their gate code deactivated and denied access to the pool until
 their account is brought current. Lease tenants will be denied use if the Landlord's
 dues are delinquent.
- 2. ALL PERSONS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK. PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO SUPERVISE THEIR CHILDREN. CHILDREN AGE 12 AND UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT (16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER).
- 3. SUMMER POOL HOURS: 7:00AM to 10:00PM
- 4. EMERGENCY CALL BOX: In case of an emergency, call 911. A RED EMERGENCY CALL BOX IS LOCATED ON THE CLUBHOUSE, WEST FRONT CORNER, AND NEAR THE BATHROOM ENTRY. A FIRST AID KIT IS LOCATED IN THE MEN'S BATHROOM. Parents, discuss with your children the purpose and proper use of the emergency call box and first aid.
- 5. **POOL KEYS**: Each resident household will be **issued one** (1) **key** at the cost of **Three Dollars** (\$3.00). A pool pass bearing the household's adults' names, address, and telephone number(s) will be attached to the key. When you come to the pool, bring your key with pass attached and hang it on the board provided next to the gate. When you leave, be sure to take your pass/key with you. The purpose of the pool passes is (1) to assist us in getting to know our neighbors, (2) to provide contact information in case of emergency, and (3) to assist in identifying trespassers. Pool passes left on the board at the end of the day will be collected and returned when contact occurs with the resident. Each **replacement key** will cost the homeowner **ten dollars** (\$10.00).
- 6. TRESPASSERS: We frequently have trouble with trespassers, especially at the beginning of pool season. If you observe persons using the pool whom you do not know, please do not be shy about asking who they are and where they live. All pool users should have at least one pool pass. If you determine that there is probable cause to believe that one or more persons are trespassing in the pool, CALL 911 and ask for police assistance. You may use the red emergency call box to call the police if you do not have a cell phone. Please remain near the area in order to identify the suspected trespassers to the police.
- 7. GUESTS: Members whose dues are current are allowed a maximum of six (6) non-resident, non-family members in the pool area at one time. When a non-resident family member (parents, grandparents, brothers, sisters, inlaws, and grandchildren) accompanies you to the pool, make sure they carry one of your family pool passes.

Greene Homeowners Association Swimming Pool Rules (2013)

With a large gathering, we ask you to be considerate of other residents using the pool and schedule your swim time or stagger your guests so as not to cause overcrowding in the pool. If you are planning a large gathering, please inform the Pool Director at least 24 hours ahead of time.

- 8. Proper swimming attire is required at all times. No cut-offs or street clothing allowed in the water.
- 9. Young children who are not potty trained are required to wear **Swimmers** An accident will cause the pool to be closed.
- 10. Swimmers must rinse off before entering the water. A poolside shower is available during pool hours.
- 11. Restroom facilities are available in the clubhouse during the pool hours. Hours for restroom use will be adjusted if improper use is observed.
- 12. Throwing of rocks, coins, frisbees, tennis balls, or any other hard or sinkable items in the pool is not allowed. Tossing soft or inflatable pool toys is allowed if the play does not monopolize the pool or interfere with swimming.
- 13. Only floats designed for 1 person may be used in the pool. No scuba equipment, inflatable boats, canoes, kayaks, etc. are allowed.
- 14. ROPED AREA: No children under 10 are allowed in roped area unless able to swim without floatation devices.
- 15. POOL FURNITURE: Do not throw in the water, stand on, climb, or abuse pool furniture in any other way.
- 16. POOL EQUIPMENT IS FOR MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY ONLY.
- 17. Radios, portable CD players, etc. must be used with earphones.
- 18. Food is not allowed in the pool area. Picnic tables on the clubhouse patio have been provided for eating. Dispose of trash in the containers provided.
- 19. By State law, no food or drink is permitted in the pool. No glass containers, alcoholic beverages, smoking, or gum chewing is permitted in the pool area.
- 20. No profanity or offensive language will be tolerated.
- 21. NO RUNNING OR HORSEPLAY IN THE POOL AREA. INCLEMENT WEATHER: You are expected to leave the pool when conditions for thunder, lightning, and rain are in the area.
- 22. Parents, please pick up toys, clothing and pool passes. All pool users, please rearrange the chairs back to orderly fashion before leaving pool area. This is your pool, keep it looking good. Keep chairs away from the pool fence where children or non-Greene residents would be tempted to climb over.
- 23. Disregard for any of the pool rules will be cause for suspension of pool privileges for the remainder of the day or longer. Reprimands will begin with a verbal warning or time out of the pool. A repeat occurrence will be cause for suspension from the pool. In the absence of a pool attendant, adult members are requested to aide in supervision for the safety and enjoyment of all swimmers.
