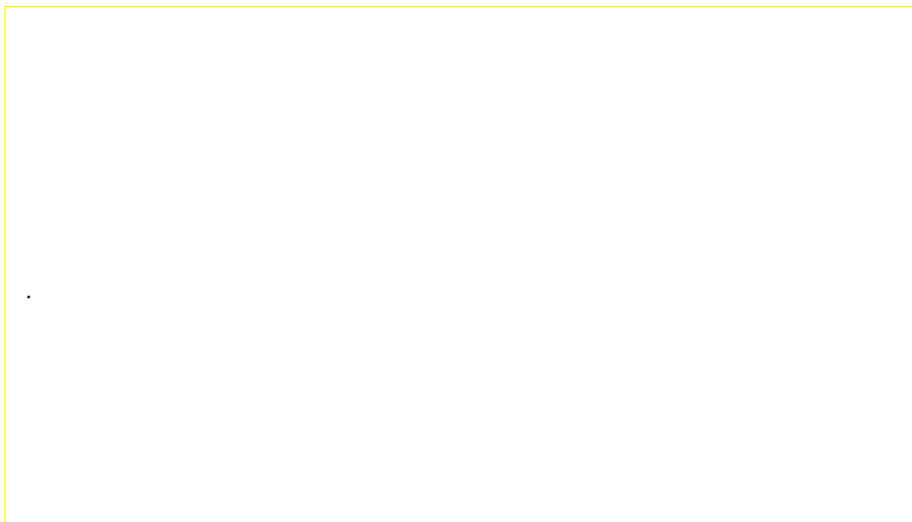


VACANCY FOR RELIEF MEALTIME SUPERVISOR
