- **Mary's Table** serves balanced hot meals Sat-Thur, 11:30-1:30 PM (not provided the first Sunday of the month).
- **Saint Martin de Porres Emergency Food Bag Program** distributes approximately 1,000 bags of food except for the first Wednesday of the month: 1:30-3:00 P.M.
- **Free showers** for women on Monday and Tuesday 8-10AM: and on Tuesday and Thursday 7:30-9:30AM for men- Both must be signed up for shower.
- **Medical Screening** is open at the Center on Wednesday mornings.
- **Free Dental Clinic** each quarter.
- **Saint Joseph's Clothes Closet** distributes free clothing on Monday's to women and children, and on Thursdays to men. 2-3PM. / Family clothing distribution: last Thursday of the month 11:30-1:30 P.M. open to all.

- **Mary's Children's Program** assists mothers in crisis with infant needs: diapers Tuesday and Thursday 9-11:00 A.M. or 2-3:00 PM.
- **Christmas Party** is held in December.

Eligibility: Children must be newborn to 18 years of age

Description: Parents experiencing a temporary crisis can arrange for their children (newborn through 18 years old) to stay with Safe Families for Children volunteers while they address the issues that led to the instability in their lives. Children are matched with families in their own community whenever possible, and placements average from one day to three months.

This program provides:

- Early Intervention: Olive Crest provides a safe alternative to child welfare custody where families are given time to address risk factors in their lives
- Child Abuse Prevention: Safe Families for Children provides an overwhelmed and resource-limited parent with a safe, temporary place for their child without threat of losing custody
- Family Support and Stabilization
