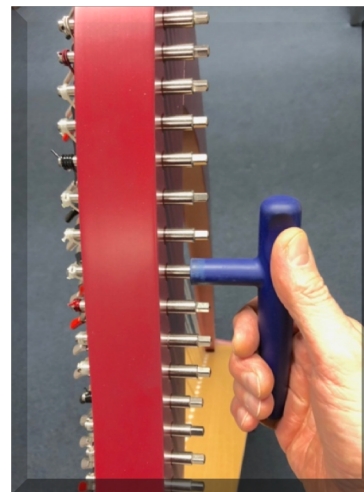
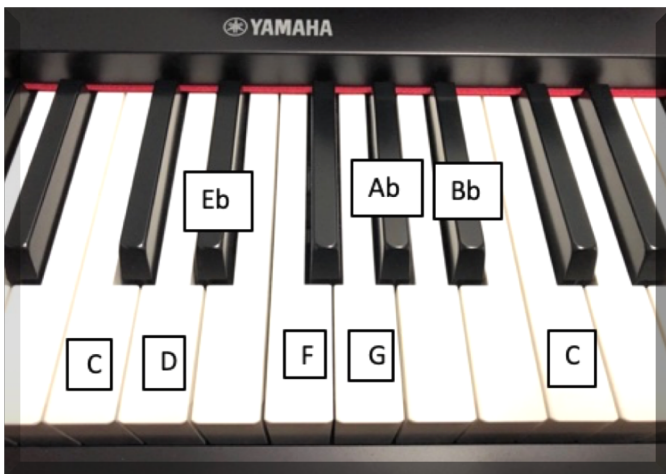
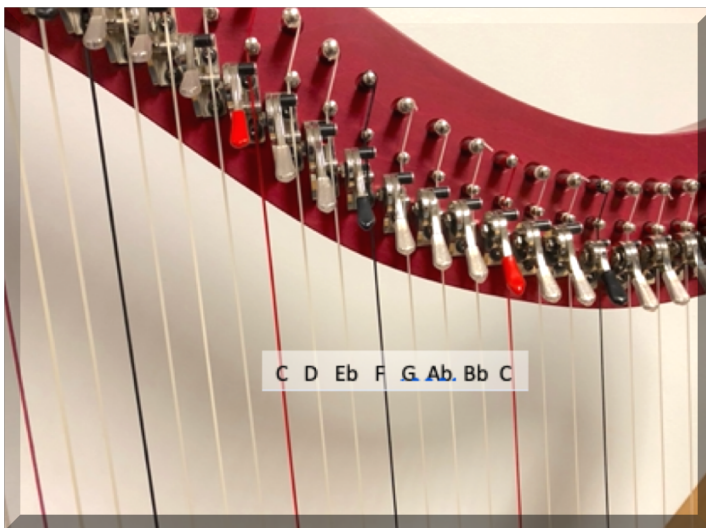


Tune Lever Harps to 'E Flat Major' (with 3 flats)

Once these procedures are put in frequent practice, harps sound their best and offer the most flexible range of keys.
