# **Description of the project:**

Researchers in this study aim to understand Mothers' experience of burnout and methods of coping with parenting demands associated with having a school-age child with ASD.

#### **Procedures:**

If you decide to take part in this study, here is what will happen:

- Hannah Barnett, M.S. MFT Doctoral Intern, will schedule an interview with you via zoom. You will receive an informed consent and all interview questions via email before your interview. This interview will take place via a secure zoom link and last approximately 45 minutes. The interviewer will ask open-ended questions related to your parenting experience and use of coping skills.
- Participants are not required to turn their camera on. Video recordings of each interview will be deleted within 24 hours. Audio files will be deleted after transcription and all identifying information will be removed from content utilized in the study.
- Participants may terminate the interview at any time or skip any question they do not wish to answer.

• Participants will receive a follow-up email with therapy resources and the option to be included in further surveys about the study or an opportunity to be interviewed again. Each participant will be assigned a random number to be included in a drawing for two \$50 gift-cards. Winner will be notified via email.

### **Risks or discomfort:**

Mothers who participate in this study will be exposed to minimal risks. Emotional difficulty may be experienced as you choose to share your parenting experiences. Participants maintain the right to take their time answering questions or to end the interview if they become overwhelmed. Therapy clinics and advocacy resources will be provided after the interview.

# Benefits of this study:

Hannah Barnett hopes to make a unique contribution to the literature surrounding the experiences of mothers of children with ASD. It is hoped that the findings of this study will provide more information and awareness on burnout and positive coping skills in mothers of children with ASD. The findings of this study may be used to help educate teachers, medical professionals, and therapists in best practices for supporting families who have a child with ASD.

### **Compensation:**

No formal compensation will be provided; however, you will be entered into a drawing for two \$50 gift cards for participating in this study.

# **Confidentiality:**

Your part in this study is confidential within legal limits. The researchers and Lee University will protect your privacy, unless they are required by law to report information to city, state or federal authorities, or to give information to a court of law. All reported, presented, and published data will have all identifying information removed. All data will be collected on paper or on password-protected computers, to which only members of the research team have access.

After completion of the research, all paper data will be securely stored in the locked lab rooms, and all computer data will be stored on password-protected computers.

### Voluntary participation and withdrawal:

All participation is voluntary. Refusal to participate in any or all aspects of this project will be immediately honored. If you decide to be in the study and change your mind, you have the right to drop out at any time.
