

**FOREST CITY BOROUGH

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2020**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY, COUNTY OF SUSQUEHANNA, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING TRANSFER OF EATING RETAIL DISPENSER LICENSE NO. R1336, LID 83012 FROM 716 MAIN STREET, HALLSTEAD, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA INTO THE BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY TO BE USED AT 1318 NORTH MAIN STREET, FOREST CITY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Liquor Code (47 P.S. §1-101, *et. seq.*) (hereinafter the "Act") authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of Eating Retail Dispenser Licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota limitations provided for in § 4-461 of the Liquor Code, if sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, if the receiving municipality agrees to the intermunicipal transfer, the receiving municipality shall issue a resolution approving the transfer of the license outside the municipality to inside the municipality after public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Forest City received an application for transfer of an eating retail dispenser license from 716 Main Street, Hallstead, Susquehanna County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to 1318 North Main Street, Forest City, Susquehanna County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on July 29, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Forest City Borough conducted a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving comments and / or recommendations of interested individuals residing within the municipality with respect to the request for transfer on October 5, 2020, after formal notice was given of the public hearing on September 23 and September 30 in the Forest City News and September 21st and September 28th in the Scranton Times; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the Act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of an Eating Retail Dispenser License into the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of Forest City Borough, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that JTP Hospitality, LLC has requested the approval of the Borough Council of the Borough of Forest City for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania Eating Retail dispenser License No. R1336, LID 83012 to its facilities, to be located at 1318 North Main Street, within the Borough of Forest City, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with the understanding that said transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and


FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council of Forest City Borough, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania finds that the transfer of an Eating Retail Dispenser license into the Borough of Forest City by JTP Hospitality, LLC will not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality or its residents; and


FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council of Forest City Borough, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approves, by adoption of this Resolution the proposed transfer of Eating Retail Dispenser License No. R1336, LID 83012, from the Borough of Hallstead, by JTP Hospitality, LLC to be located at the 1318 North Main Street, in Forest City Borough, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the license transfer is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
