To achieve this, we turned to our Concept54 glazing system, a partition system known for its versatility and performance. As the glazing sector continually undergoes a dynamic evolution, we maintain our unwavering dedication to research and development, ensuring our systems seamlessly align with the exacting requirements of contemporary architecture.

Concept54, a testament to our commitment to British innovation, seamlessly combines acoustic insulation with an effortlessly elegant aesthetic.

Our ability to manufacture this pioneering system in-house at City Concepts' dedicated facility further underscores our drive for innovation and quality. The combination of 1x layer of 12.8mm acoustic laminate glass and 1x layer of 12mm fully reeded glass not only ensures acoustic privacy but also adds a touch of elegance.

In the world of ironmongery, we selected Franchi cranked back-to-back pull handles in a refined RAL 9005 finish.

Ironmongery has become an integral part of glazing design, where form and function are inseparable and so these handles, besides their functional excellence, contribute to the overall aesthetics of the space.

Slimline door closers, also in RAL 9005, were incorporated for smooth and controlled door operation.

As technology advances, we embrace the latest advancements in door hardware to provide our clients with spaces that are not only beautiful but also highly functional. This integration of technology and design sets the stage for modern office requirements.
