Qualifications & Requirements:

- > Applicant must be a graduating student of Waxahachie Independent School District in 2024.
- > Applicant must maintain a G.P.A. of 2.0 or higher.
- > Applicant must be enrolled in a community college, 4-year college or university, or trade school for the fall semester of 2024.
- > The application must include one (1) copy of your official high school transcript.
- > The application does **NOT** require copies of SAT and/or ACT scores.
- > Applicant must provide two (2) signed letters of recommendation from a faculty member of Waxahachie Independent School District.
- > The applicant must qualify as to leadership, character, dependability, personality, ambition and reputation, as deemed appropriate and proper by the Waxahachie Ex-Students' Association Board of Directors and/or the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- > Financial need will be considered.
- > Those interested in applying for the Educator Scholarship must be studying to become an educator.
- > Signed application and all supporting documents/materials must be submitted to the Waxahachie Ex-Students' Association (P.O. Box 906, Waxahachie 75168) and post marked on or before **April 20, 2024.**
