

ABW T-BAR TRAIL RIDE 2022 AZ Rider



The 2022 T-Bar Trail Ride took place on Thursday April 7th. The stops for this adult-themed fundraiser were at Cheetah's, Christie's, and Platinum Plus. There were about 450 participants. It was explained that two different map routes were given out. By splitting up the group, the clubs were better able serve the riders by their not being overrun with everyone arriving at once.

It is a self-paced ride in support of breast cancer charities. The T-Bar Trail Ride has been taking place since 2006. Lisa Cyr of AZ Bike Week shared, "This is the longest running ride of Arizona Bike Week. Some may say that raising funds for breast cancer chari-

ties by visiting a bunch of strip clubs seems a little irreverent. But if you can combine having a good time with doing a good deed, how can you find fault in that? We'll keep doing this ride as long as people keep wanting to participate."

Last stop was at AZ Bike Week at WestWorld in Scottsdale. Riders received raffle tickets as part of their registration, and this is when the drawings took place. Some of the prizes donated by the participating gentlemen's clubs included Ride Gloves, Helmets, and discount cards for the Christie's Cabaret clubs. ets and 2 Tickets on the 3rd baseline. There was also a Premium Bottle Service for 4 people {1 premium bottle}.
