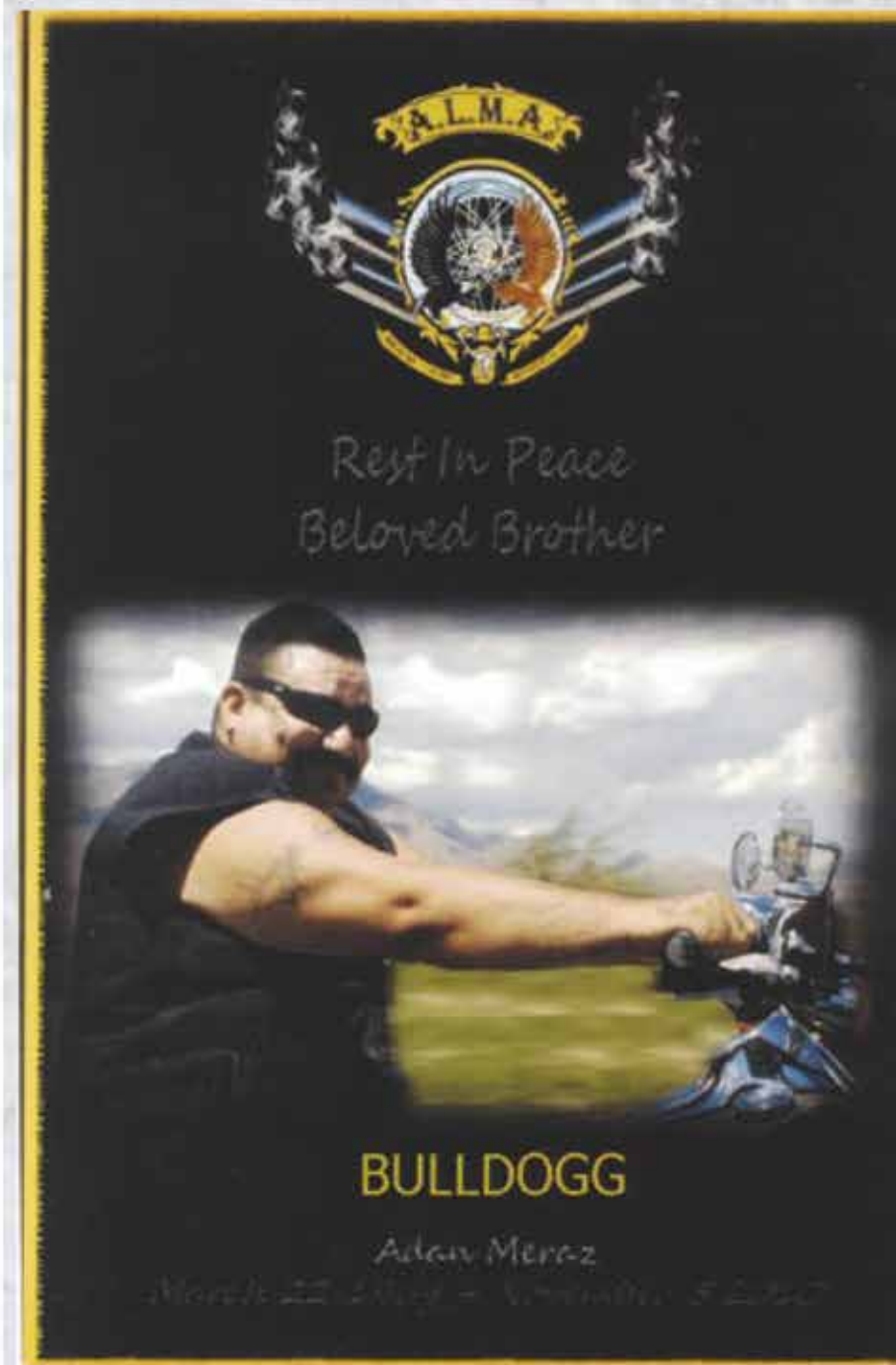


Gone But Not Forgotten
