Transition To Work

The Community Intergated Training for Employment (CITE) program is the focal point of the transition to work approach implemented by Fairhaven School through The Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities (TCBDD). The transition to work team consists of certified teachers, classroom assistants and job coaches, all serving the goal of helping students prepare to leave high school. The transition from graduation to adult life can be difficult to maneuver and our team is here to help students manage their way through the process.

The Trumbull County Fairhaven Team works with students, families, teachers and other members of each student's IEP team to develop personalized transition plans. Each plan takes into consideration preferences, interests, needs and strengths of the individual.
