CITE

What is CITE?

CITE is a training program operated by Fairhaven School through the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities. The program provides real work experiences for students to help prepare them for competitive employment as they plan for life after school.

What are the eligibility requirements for the CITE program?

- * Students must have a current Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- * Students must be independent in their use of the restroom
- * Students must be self-regulatory regarding behavioral support
- * Students must be unrestricted regarding imminent health care needs

What is expected of program participants?

- * Appropriate dress and appearance
- * Regular and punctual attendance
- * Respect for and adherence to work rules

How does a student apply for the CITE program?

- * If the student meets the eligibility requirements, application can be made by completing the application form and submitting it to **Jessica Mazei** at Fairhaven School
