



STUDENT EARNED INCOME EXCLUSION (SEIE) FACT SHEET

Who is Eligible? Individuals who receive SSI (Title XVI)

- The Student Earned Income Exclusion is for students under the age of 22 who receive SSI cash benefits and earn income while attending school.
- In 2022, SSA will not count up to \$2,040 of earned income per month while you are attending school and working. The maximum yearly exclusion for 2022 is \$8,230.

In order to be considered a student you must be attending school in one (1) of the following ways:

- Grades 7-12 for at least 12 hours per week (includes home-schooling); or
- College or university for at least 8 hours per week; or
- Training course to prepare for employment for at least 12 hours per week; or
- Online, through an online school, college or university, approved by the Social Security Administration.

You *must* report your monthly earnings AND your student status to the Social Security Administration.
