**To the Presidents, Vice Presidents, Directors, Vicars, Headmasters/Headmistresses and Teachers  
Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord!**

Wish you all a blessed New Year!

By the Grace of God, we completed the Sunday school activities of the last year. We hope and pray that God will continue to shower His blessings in the New Year as well. The cooperation and able leadership of all the office bearers at all levels of Sunday school is earnestly solicited to carry on with our mission. All are kindly requested to follow this circular for the smooth functioning of Sunday school activities.

### A. Textbooks

We follow the textbooks prepared by OSSAE since 2015. The textbooks are available at OKR Office, Nagpur, and OSSAE Central Office Devalokam, Kottayam.

We are following the grade system since 2016. There is no Project work for the class 10<sup>th</sup> and class 12<sup>th</sup> Regular students. Minimum pass mark is 35 out of 100.

Successful completion of Class XII examination confers the title and certificate of **“Orthodox Vedapraveen Diploma”** to the student.

We have certain special eligibility criteria for Class XII: In order to register for Class XII examination, the ‘Regular’ students should have successfully completed Class XI. A student who has passed Class XI can write Class XII examination as a ‘Private’ student only after two years of completing XI. A student who has passed Class X can write Class XII examination as a ‘Private’ student, only after three years after passing Class X. Such ‘Private’ students will have questions from class XI and XII textbooks for the examination.

A regular student who has completed class XI and could not continue in Class XII due to change of residence may appear for the Class XII examination as a private student in the next year. A request for the same has to be

sent to OKR office and get a prior approval before the registration for examination. Else, the student is eligible to write the exam after two years only.

For Class XII, two activities are mandatory as practical work for Regular students.

1. Attend the orientation program conducted by the candidate's Diocese.

Orientation program should have two requirements:

- a) The orientation program should be regarding the Teaching Methods.
  - b) Any one chapter from Class XII textbook should be taught to the students by a teaching expert.
2. Candidate should prepare three lesson plans and teach three classes in candidate's Sunday school under the supervision of the headperson/class teacher. Detailed suggestions for the preparation of the lesson plan are given in Class XII textbook. Teaching practice can be done during regular classes or OVBS.

Attending Orientation program is not compulsory for Private students of 12<sup>th</sup> standard. They can do the specified project instead of the Orientation program.

The activities mentioned above should be completed under the leadership of District Inspector before **15<sup>th</sup> September 2022**. (In case of units with more than five students, the activities may be done in the respective units under the guidance of the District Inspector).

### **D. Sathyajyothi Online Course**

The *Sathyajyothi* online theological study program under the auspices of St. Thomas Orthodox Theological Seminary, Nagpur, will enrich our teachers by providing necessary information about the Bible, worship, faith, and history of the Church. This is an online course using the advancement in technology. This is the first of its kind in our Church. More details are available from the course website [www.stotsonlinestudy.org](http://www.stotsonlinestudy.org). We earnestly recommend all teachers to register for this course taking into account the challenges we face nowadays in terms of the faith and practices of the Church.

### **E. Appointment of New Teachers**

As per the Circular No: OKR/02/2021 dated 18.06.2021, eligibility for appointment as Sunday School Teachers are as follows:

1. Those who have passed the "Veda Praveen" Diploma Examination.
2. Those who have completed the Seminary studies or Mission Center studies.
3. In case of emergency, those who have completed the Divya Bodhanam (POCE) course or the Sathyajyothi online course can be appointed as temporary Sunday school teachers with the permission of the Diocesan Metropolitan. However, they should pass "Veda Praveen" Diploma within two years after joining the Sunday school.

## F. Satellite Examination Centre

In recent years, there are many students, especially from the Gulf countries, who pursue their higher secular education in different parts of India. Such students in Kerala can write their Sunday school Class X and XII examination at OSSAE office Devalokam, Kottayam. There is provision for any OKR student to write his/her examination at any other Sunday school centers of OKR with prior permission from the center. This should be clearly informed to the OKR Director at the time of the registration of board examination.

## G. Half Yearly and Annual Examination 2022

All seven Dioceses and the Gulf Region must follow the year plan strictly and conduct classes as per the schedule (See Appendix I). The half yearly examination have to be conducted at unit level on **Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022** in the Gulf region and **Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2022** in India. The Annual Examination for all the classes up to IX and XI should be held on **Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022** in the Gulf and on **Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> December 2022** in India. The question papers for examinations of all classes except the class X and Class XII annual examinations must be given by the respective diocese. However, any change of date for the examination at the diocesan level should be informed to the OKR Director in advance. The syllabus for annual examination is given in the *Appendix I* of this circular.

The candidate needs 60% attendance to write the annual examination.

Percentage division of Marks for Annual examination for classes Jesus Kids (KG) to Class III are as follows:

1. 40% for half yearly examination
2. 50% for final examination
3. 10% for attendance

Percentage division of marks for Annual examination for all classes IV to XI except classes X and XII are as follows:

1. 40% for half yearly examination
2. 10% for project work; deadline 15<sup>th</sup> October 2022
3. 40% for final examination
4. 10% for attendance

Class X and Class XII examinations will be held on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2022 in the Gulf region** and on **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 in India**. The online registration must be done on or before **1<sup>st</sup> October 2022**. Late application may be accepted till **15<sup>th</sup> October 2022** with a late fee of Rs. 150/- for India and Rs. 250/- Gulf regions. Please adhere to this deadline strictly. After the deadline no application will be entertained.

The Directors will collect the exam fee from their respective diocese and the total amount shall be remitted to the OSSAR-OKR account and also need to submit the transaction details to the OSSAE-OKR office.

After the last day of the registration, a copy of the list of students appearing from each Diocese/Sub-Region will be sent to the Directors and they must verify and send a document of confirmation to the OSSAE-OKR office with comments/corrections, if any. Directors should inform the number of examination centres and its mailing address to send the examination materials from OKR office.

There will not be any separate reminder for the application. The HMs are advised to inform the students about the online Google application for OKR examination in advance.

**If there is any change in the examination process, all Sunday school units needs to comply with it.**

The fee structure of examination is as follows:

Regular Student:	Rs. 200/- in India and Rs. 500/- outside India
Private Student:	Rs. 250/- in India and Rs. 500/- outside India

The Examination Centre fee will be as shown below:

1-10 students:	Rs. 200/- in India and Rs. 400/- outside India
1-25 students:	Rs. 300/- in India and Rs. 500/- outside India
1-26 and above:	Rs. 500/- in India and Rs. 750/- outside India

- If a Sunday school student goes to other city for his/her secular studies, such student can attend Sunday school in any church in the place where he/she studies and take a declaration letter from the Vicar and HM of that Church regarding his/her attendance and submit it to the home parish and it will be considered for calculation of attendance in an academic year. If the student wishes to appear for examination in the church where he/she studies, the student can get declaration letter from the home parish and submit it to the church where he/she studies and can appear for examination there. This holds good for Class X and XII examinations also. Only thing is that, if the student is registered for examination in home parish and wants to appear for the examination at the church where he/she studies, OKR must be informed at the time of registration for the examination.
- Students with learning difficulties may intimate OKR office well in advance to get special consideration in exams. A medical certificate has to be sent along with the application form in such cases. Please refer to *Annexure A* of the constitution for more information.

## H. Examination Materials

Examination materials such as Hall Tickets, Facing Sheets, Attendance Sheet, and Circular of Rules and Regulations regarding examination will be sent to units/Districts. The HM/District Inspector/Vicar or any other duly authorized person can open the packet to see that everything is in order. If there is any discrepancy, they have to intimate the same to OKR office immediately.

If the examination is held at Diocese, or District Level, the question papers will be sent to the Diocese/District officials, who reside near to the place of the examination center. The question papers would be in a separate sealed packet. The question papers are to be kept under safe custody till the date of examination.

The question paper should be opened only just before the commencement of the examination in front of the Vicar (if possible – for Unit Level), Teachers and students. The Supervisors of the examination must follow the rules and regulations strictly. **The students must write their name and register number on the facing sheet only.**

## I. Class X and Class XII Examination Results 2021

The Class X and Class XII examinations will be held on **14<sup>th</sup> January 2022** in Gulf Region and on **16<sup>th</sup> January 2022** in India. The results will be published on **21<sup>st</sup> February 2022**. It is expected that the certificates will be ready by **April 2022**.

## J. Arts Competition 2022

All the seven Dioceses and the Gulf region are requested to follow the OKR rules in conducting the Arts Competitions. The headmasters are to be extra cautious to give the correct information about the age of the students and their attendance to avoid unnecessary disputes. HMs has to admit students as per their age and the secular classes. There should not be a big gap (more than 1 year) between the two. However, to avoid confusion, the participants of the diocesan level competitions should carry a certificate (of the HM) stating that they are regular Sunday school students and that they have at least 60% attendance in the current year.

The organizers of competitions have to take note of the following changes:

1. For all competitions, which involve the use of Bible, Ecumenical version of the NRSV must be used.
2. The sub-juniors will have a competitions at the unit level only.
3. For Group Song competitions, the children will be divided in to three groups only: all the students up to

age 8 will be called **Buds**, those who are in the age group of 9-13 will be the **Premiers** and those above 14 up to 19 will be named as **Teens**. **The Buds will not have any competition above the district level.**

4. The time allotted for group song will be three to five minutes. As per the decision taken in AGM 2017, a team will have three to five students only. They have to prove their musical talent only; any other type of presentation or choreographic elements will not be entertained (e.g., presenting a couple while singing a marriage song). Those who do not follow the rules will be disqualified.
5. Each Diocese has the freedom to introduce other competitions like drawing, painting etc. and it can be for a duration of half an hour.

This year's syllabus for the Arts competitions is given in **Appendix II**. All the competitions should be held in the months of August, September, October and November at Unit, District, and Diocesan levels respectively.

### **K. OVBS 2022**

All the units should conduct the Orthodox Vacation Bible School. The guidelines for conducting OVBS-OKR have already been published. The date and time for conducting it shall be decided at unit level, considering the local holidays during Dussera-Diwali, Christmas and summer vacation. ### **L. Sunday School Day 2022**

As per the Kalpana No. HES/HH/50/2019 of His Holiness Baselios Marthoma Paulose II the Sunday school day will be celebrated on first Sunday after the feast of "Mayaltho" in the month of February. This year Sunday Schools under OKR shall celebrate the Sunday school day on 4<sup>th</sup> February 2022 in the Gulf region and 6<sup>th</sup> February 2022 in India.

### **M. Charity Day 2022**

Charity/Mercy Day should be celebrated on the last Sunday of the November of each year. At the beginning of the year, instructions should be given to the teachers and students to collect money for charity and hand it over by the end of Sunday school academic year. This is an encouragement and opportunity for the students to learn stewardship practices right from the early childhood days. In order to inculcate the culture of mission, we need to give the students an opportunity to visit any charitable institution near the parish. The visit will certainly create a sense of service to the needy in the minds of students. The HM and teachers can organize this in consultation with the Vicar.

The charity collection from all the OKR Sunday School Dioceses should be sent to the OSSAE-OKR office for the charity project of OKR.

### **N. Medical and Educational Aid**

Medical and Educational funds are available to the students. The Educational aid will be distributed to the regular attendees and students who have completed class 10 in Sunday school. Medical aid will be distributed to every student irrespective of any norms. The Diocesan Directors will be responsible to do the necessary scrutiny before forwarding the application to the OSSAE-OKR office for disbursement. Medical/Education fund allocated as per the Budget is available anytime during the financial year.

### **O. Extempore Speech Competition**

In order to promote Public speaking skills among the Sunday school children, there will be an extempore speech competition at OSSAE-OKR headquarters. A single topic will be given to all the participants 10 minutes prior to his/her turn. This competition is only for the Seniors and Secondary category. One student from each Diocese can participate in this competition for each category. One topper from each category will be awarded a cash prize of Rs.10000/- along with a trophy and certificate. Participation certificates will be issued to all

participants. The language for the extempore speech competition will be English only. Date of Extempore competition will be intimated later.

### **Conclusion**

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**Notes:**

1. All the levels of the Arts competition should be over by the month of December as per our Year plan. These have to be held in the months of August, September, October, and November at Unit, District, and Diocesan levels, respectively.

3. The age limit for the three groups will be the following: Buds (up to 8 years); Premiers (9-13); Teens (14-19).

Age Calculation for the academic year 2022 will be calculated as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022. Age for categories as per DOB is given below:

- Sub junior : 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015 onwards
- Junior : 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014
- Intermediate : 1<sup>st</sup> January 2009 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2011
- Seniors : 1<sup>st</sup> January 2006 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2008
- Secondary : 1<sup>st</sup> January 2003 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2005

## 6. Appendix III

### Project work of the Students during 2022

#### General Guidelines

- The Project work is not a classroom assignment. The students can do it in their leisure time or in the break time when they are tired of learning secular subjects.
- One of the projects given below can be selected for this year. Project of the children of classes IV to VI are to be conducted on an oral level only. Students of Classes VII to XI should submit it in a well hand-written form.
- The length of the written project should be from five to ten pages. Photos and other data can be added, if available.
- Teachers and parents should help the child in developing his/her ideas. Teachers can select books and websites and give the name of these to the students. However, each project should be an independent work of the student.
- The Class teacher should maintain a register for the internal assessment of the student and the marks for the project should be entered in it. It shall be examined by the HM and verified by the parish priest. All those who are in this process should remind themselves that we are serving the Lord and that Christian values should not be compromised at any cost.
- The mark of the project work can be as follows: Punctuality (2 marks), Text (3marks), Comprehension of the idea (3 marks), and Presentation/Neatness (2 marks). **15<sup>th</sup> October 2022** is the cut-off date for the submission of the project at unit level.
- Selected projects can be presented in front of the people during the anniversary of the Sunday school or on Sunday school day.

#### Themes for Projects:

<b>Class IV</b>	1) Recite the fruits of the Spirit with Bible references 2) Recite the names of 12 Apostles
<b>Class V</b>	1) Recite the "I am sayings" of Jesus with references. 2) Make note of maximum number of liturgical books used in the Church and their occasions of use
<b>Class VI</b>	1) Name all the books of the Old Testament 2) Narrate briefly about the life and contribution of Metropolitan H. G. Alvares Mar Yulios of blessed memory
<b>Class VII</b>	1) Write briefly about St. George 2) Write the main events in the sacrament of Holy Matrimony and its significance.
<b>Class VIII</b>	1) Prepare a note on all the Sundays of The Great Lent 2) Write briefly about the life of Pampady Thirumeni
<b>Class IX</b>	1) Write briefly about the life of St. John Chrysostom 2) Prepare a report on the Synod of Diamper and its effects on the Malankara Orthodox Church
<b>Class XI</b>	1) Write briefly about the contributions of Metropolitan H. G. Geevarghese Mar Osthathios of blessed memory. 2) Write briefly about the establishment of the Catholicate in Malankara.

**Class XII (for private students who cannot do practical work)**

Prepare a detailed study on (Baptism or Marriage or Anointing the Sick or Feast of Christmas) based on the liturgical text used focusing mainly on prayers, hymns, symbols and rituals. (This should be typed on A4 size Page, 10 pages, Times New Roman, font size 12 spacing 1.5, Justified). Candidates need to submit this during their Annual Examination and it has to be sent to the OKR office along with the answer sheet. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.

**Class X (for private students instead of Prayer and Hymns)**

Private candidates for Class X can opt for either Viva Voce or for Project work. Project work topic shall be 'Role of Sunday School in fostering Justice and Peace'. (This should be typed on A4 size Page, 10 pages, Times New Roman, font size 12 spacing 1.5, Justified). Candidates need to submit this during their Annual Examination and it has to be sent to the OKR office along with the answer sheet. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
