Annual Report 2019:

In a world with an ever-widening wealth gap, children are often left behind with few chances of choosing their destiny. Children from very poor communities are seldom supported by their families of origin in their schooling, they lack role models in their community to look up to, and they are more likely to fall ill and be worst hit by adversities. It is especially difficult for very poor children to stay in school, as often their precarious living conditions force them to abandon school to find work.

SACSAS Academy started its journey to provide free quality education to UNDERPRIVILEGED/ DOWNTRODDEN children of exceedingly low-income family in the entire state of Manipur. SACSAS thrives to promote, spread, and impart quality education, and to provide academic opportunities to make them as good as privilege kids and improve and enhance the health and well-being of the community.

In parallel, we have maintained our holistic village approach together with the village kings empowering entire villages and communities towards collective sustainable development. We would like to thank Martin Huckerby who have been generous enough to provide the school needs. Since its founding, the SACSAS Academy has been able to provide quality education to over 2500 children and over 880 students have completed their educational path, from primary to professional school, obtaining a professional school diploma.

1. Educational achievements in 2019:

- Over 110 students from 4 villages in and around Maojang Village were provided quality education
- Over 90 students from Kumbi village were provided quality education
- 12 students graduated and went to a nearby High School.
- Retention rate: 94%
- Pass rate: 95%

2. SACSAS Academy helped resolved the Water distribution issue:

Tap water management and distribution of Moirang municipal area is handled by Village Sanitation Committee. To make sure that the committee is functioning properly we performed the following activities:

- Conducted surprise visits to the water filtration area
- Periodic monitoring, making sure that the water filtering process is being done properly
- Set up an awareness program to use water efficiently and not waste tap water



3. Societal conflicts / Ethnic conflicts:

- Supported the smaller ethnic groups to instill the power of communal harmony and to develop motivational integrity among various communities
- Met communal leaders, listened to their grievances, and reported to the Government departments and facilitated them to meet the concern Government offers
- Facilitated and demanded setting of power supply and led the electrification effort of the villages MolpheiTampak, Leishembung, New Dampi, Shiyang, and Maoyang.
