## Suthmiting a Photo

Yes, photos can add a fun eye-catching element to your billboard design. However, the size of the image file that you submit needs to be correct in order for your photo to look great.

## - Photos are Always a Bitmap or Pixel-Based Files

Your photo file consists of dots on a grid. The more dots per inch, the clearer your image will look when enlarged to billboard size.

We like to see photos at 300 dpi (dots per inch) at $1 / 2$ inch to 1 foot scale.
So if your photo will be 10 feet wide on your billboard it should be a 5 inch wide file at 300 dpi (jpg file size will be approximately 400-600K in size).


This is a $40 \mathrm{~K} . j p g$ file.
The size you would typically find on a website.
It looks OK in this small size........

But look what happens, when you enlarge it! Yuk


This file is 470 K

Wow, what a difference that makes!
