



RECOVERY OF HUMAN REMAINS HOST AGENCY INFORMATION

Thank you so much for your interest in hosting our 3-day Recovery of Human Remains training! I have included some information below to explain the class set-up, as well as what we would need from you as a host agency.

Class Information:

- 3-day class, either Monday-Wednesday or Wednesday-Friday (24 hours of training credit)
- Class is IAI Crime Scene Certification, ABMDI continuing education, and Georgia POST approved.
- Maximum number of students is 30 (ideal minimum is 12, but this is flexible)
- We would need a training classroom large enough for 30 students.
- We also need an outdoor space, either grassy area or in the woods, nearby with permission to bury 3-5 skeletons, depending on number of students. Typically, we do not want more than 6 students per burial.
- We ask the host agency and any other surrounding agencies to bring large tools you may have, including shovels (flat and spade), screens, buckets, metal probes, etc.). I will supply all other smaller equipment and things we need for the class.
- I will visit earlier or just prior to the class to bury the plastic anatomical skeletons in preparation for the class. If your agency has any members that can help me dig and re-bury the skeletons, that would be very helpful.
- Suncoast Forensics handles all registration through the website or by sending invoices upon request, so the host agency does not have to worry about that.
- Host agency automatically gets one free seat (no matter how many people register)
- If you can help disseminate the flyer to crime scene units at other agencies around you, that would be very helpful.
