The Plumbers Joint Apprentice \& Educational Committee is open for applications on a yearly basis. The application period for the 2021-2022 School Year runs from May 1, 2020 to April 30 2021. Upon completing an application with the Apprentice Committee, the applicant will be placed on an out-of-work list. As jobs become available, the applicant will be offered employment with one of our Plumbing Contractors.

At the end of the application year, all Applicants are scheduled to begin the "Selection Procedure" used by the Apprenticeship Committee. The first part of the selection process is a Written Evaluation given by the Plumbers Joint Apprentice and Educational Committee.

After taking the Written Evaluation, the applicant will be scheduled for an interview with the Apprenticeship Committee. This Committee is made up of both, Labor and Management Representatives. 7. If Veteran, furnish a copy of DD214
8. Satisfy the Educational Committee that you have the ability and aptitude to master the skills of the trade
9. Agree to attend night classes for the Five Year Term Apprenticeship
10. Agree to comply with the Standards of Apprenticeship
11. Application Fee required in the amount of $\$ 40.00$ (NON-REFUNDABLE)
