### **BUILDING RESTORATION FUND**

Our 3 church buildings need immediate care and attention. There is a long list to do to keep our buildings safe, functioning and open for service. They also need immediate restoration works. Lots of money has already been spent on bringing the buildings to acceptable Health and Safety regulations (meeting today's government instructions) in order to be properly insured and safe places for everyone. Much still need to be done. Our weekly income (mainly through rents and collections) mostly covers our day to day running expenses. Expenses and bills are always rising, Regular benefactors have also passed away. We need to find ways to increase our income.

As one of our proposals, I'm setting up a new fund for each parish, named BUILDING FUND, that will raise money specifically for the restoration and upkeeping of each particular church and buildings. This fund already exist in Our Lady and St Peter in Bridlington and for more than 20 years people have been contributing to it through standing orders and other donations. I wish to extend this type of fund to all 3 churches. Starting this weekend, at every last weekend of the month, we will have a second collection in aid of the building fund.
