WHAT WE DO

Call Response

In 2022 we responded to 1,012 calls for assistance. Those calls included EMS, EMS assist, fires, hazardous materials incidents, motor vehicle accidents, and rescue calls.

Training

We typically run over 60 in house drills each year typically on Wednesday and Friday evenings and during the day on Wednesdays mornings. Additional training is provided free to members by Erie County and New York State for those who are interested.

Community Service

We are also very active in the community attended parades, doing fire prevention, raising money for Children's Hospital, as well as having Halloween at our firehouse and taking Santa around the fire district.

Social Functions

We have various social functions throughout the year for our members to attend including an adult Christmas party, Family Picnic, an Easter celebration, and other events like bowling or a brewery tour. We also have a softball team that plays in the Cheektowaga Volunteer Firemen's Softball League on Thursday evenings in the summer.



Overview

Doyle Hose Company No. 2 is a 100% Volunteer Fire Company that operates within the Doyle Fire District and serves the southwest portion of the Town of Cheektowaga, New York. We operate an EMS light rescue vehicle, an engine and a squad.

In addition to answering calls we also have a social side that does a lot of community service work and offers various social functions throughout the year.

We typically have a few fundraisers a year to raise money. The largest by far is our Fall Raffle which is typically held in September and includes both a money and sportsman raffle on the same day.

A Brief History

On February 24th, 1924, at the regular meeting of the Clinton Garden Taxpayers' Association held at Mr. Joseph Galamb's Hall at 2070 Clinton Street a motion was made by Mr. Peter Kojm and seconded by Mr. Andrew Partacz to organize a fire department for the purpose of getting lower fire insurance rates in our neighborhood.
