The Sanctuary Remodel Prayer Team meets every other Tuesday evening for prayer and meditation. Scan the QR code to submit your confidential prayer request today!






Kyle Wolfe is putting a team of volunteers together to mow the church's property. Call the Church Office to help or see Kyle.


# **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!**
