Why 2-1-1?

2-1-1 is easy to remember. It is a simple 3-digit phone number that has been designated in the U.S. and Canada to provide information and referrals to health, human and social services organizations.

2-1-1 is comprehensive. Our resource database includes more than 750 programs that provide free or low-cost services in all communities within Butte County. Our database includes services provided by local, county, state and federal government, local and national non-profits, churches, volunteer groups, and other entities.

2-1-1 is available in multiple communication platforms: You can access our resource information any way you like; over the phone by dialing 2-1-1 or 866-916-3566, via text message by texting your zip code to TXT211 (898211), by searching our database at Butte211.org and HelpCentral.org, or via email by using the contact sheet on our websites.

2-1-1 is available when you are: Our online database and the 2-1-1 help line is available 24/7. Services by text message are available M-F: 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Emails received through our websites are typically answered within the next business day.

2-1-1 is free, confidential & multilingual: All of our services are free, confidential and multilingual. (Your plan's standard text messaging fees may apply for people texting into to 2-1-1.)
