PUBLIC SAFETY COLLABORATION PROGRAM PROGRESS UPDATE

This comprehensive program will provide The Metro District with:

- 1. Private security to patrol the community, 24 hours/day, 7 days a week, for 12 months
- 2. Dispatch phone # for immediate support
- 3. A comprehensive list of property owners, managers, businesses and business managers to strengthen our collaboration efforts
- 4. Monitoring and case management of problematic bus stops in partnership with Phoenix PD and Bus Transit
- 5. Identified priority areas for outreach and services in partnership with the City of Phx
- 6. Continuous monitoring and case managment to assure properties in the area are maintained to city codes
- 7. Community Improvement Projects as identified by program participants
- 8. Bulk trash removal of shopping carts and large discarted property

Our Cactus Park Police Precinct, City Council, and City Departments are all in support of this effort.

We are currently gaining commitments from Lead Sponsors and then we will have a full fundraising campaign later this year!

TOTAL COST for all 5 elements is \$600,000.00 Divide that by 30 properties = \$20,000/yr or \$1,667/mo each (That's about \$1.83 per hour for security service AND program administration!) Your donation is TAX **DEDUCTABLE!**
