The goal of these visits is to create a comprehensive list of action items that will collectively deter criminal activity from the area.

Included at these visits are;

10 PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS FROM OUR RECENT SITE VISIT:

1. Added 25 more "No Trespassing" signs
2. Updated 8 Authority to Arrest with Phx PD
3. Added 5 new resource posters to the area
4. Added 8 businesses to our contact list
5. Added "No Loitering" signs to 2 bus stops
6. Removed a broken advertising bench
7. Removed graffiti from bus stop/businesses
8. Delivered 8 bucket/picker sets
9. Created an individual improvement checklist for a problematic property
10. Created a list of preferred vendors offering discounts for landscape rocks, paving and trees.
