Sadly history tells us all the apostles suffered for their faith and died violently except John who died a natural death as an old man. King Herod had James, the son of Zebedee killed; Peter and Andrew were crucified; Thomas was pierced with swords; Phillip was arrested and cruelly put to death; Matthew was stabbed to death; Bartholomew died as a martyr; James, son of Alpheus, was stoned and clubbed to death; Simon the Zealot was killed after refusing to sacrifice to the sun god; Matthias died by burning; Paul was beheaded.


Matthew 4:18-22
