What do we do?

We collect personal information only when needed and use it to operate, maintain, improve, and personalize our website. We may communicate with you directly or through partners for customer service, updates, and marketing. We use log files and cookies to analyze trends, track users' movements and preferences, and customize content. We do not sell advertising, and we do not have advertising partners. Information we collect

How we use your information

We use the information we collect in various ways, including:

- Provide, operate, and maintain our website.
- Improve, personalize, and expand our website.

- Develop new products, services, features, and functionality.

We may communicate with you directly or through one of our partners, including for customer service, to provide you with updates and other information relating to the website and for marketing and promotional purposes.

We may also use the information to:

- Find and prevent fraud based on internal or external reviews that we must conduct or assist.

Files and Record

We follow a standard procedure for using our files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and are part of hosting services' analytics. The information collected by log files includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. These sources of information are not linked to any personally identifiable information. The information is used to analyze trends, administer the site, track users' movement, and gather demographic information.

Cookies

Like any other website, we use 'cookies.' These cookies store information, including visitors' preferences and the pages on the website that the visitor accessed or visited. The information is used to optimize the users' experience by customizing our web page content based on visitors' browser type or other information.

When you visit our website, you can determine how to use this information and choose to turn off cookies through your browser options. Third-party websites of specific web browsers provide more information about how they manage cookies.

Third Party Privacy Policies

CCPA Privacy Rights (Do Not Sell My Personal Information)

We want you to be aware of your rights under the CCPA, which, among other rights, provides California consumers the right to:

GDPR Data Protection Rights

We want you to be aware of your data protection rights under GDPR. Every user is entitled to the following:

- **Right to access:** You can request copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- **Right to rectification:** You can request that we correct any inaccurate information and complete the incomplete information.
- **Right to erasure:** Under certain conditions, you can request that we erase your personal data.
- **Right to restrict processing:** Under certain conditions, you have the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal data.
- **Right to object to processing:** Under certain conditions, you have the right to object to our processing of your personal data.
- **Right to data portability:** Under certain conditions, you can request that we transfer the data collected to another organization or directly to you.

We have **one month** to respond to your request. Please contact us if you would like to exercise any of these rights.

Children's Information

Another priority of ours is protecting children while using the Internet. We encourage parents and guardians to observe, participate in, monitor, and guide their online activity.
