## Hello!

Do you have a little time on your hands? Are you interested in helping others, and helping our community? Our Sisters' House Homeless Shelter is currently looking for volunteers in a number of different capacities. OSH is a 10-bed shelter located right here in Tomahawk. We assist persons experiencing homelessness to get back on their feet by providing a warm, homelike place to stay while they do things like find employment and look for a place to live.

The shelter is staffed around the clock by a combination of paid and volunteer staff. A volunteer shift is usually 4 hours long, and you can schedule when and how often works for you. We have people who come in every week, and people who come in every month- it's up to you. Volunteers interact with residents, answer the phones, and make sure rules are being followed. It's easy, it's fun, and we train you in our procedures and rules. All of OSH's residents have to go through a background check and are required to maintain sobriety, so you won't be around anyone with a history of violence or dangerous behavior.

We are also looking to put together a shorter-term committee of volunteers to organize a couple of fundraisers. Before Covid, we hosted an annual Spaghetti Dinner and a Soup Cook-Off, and we'd like to resume one or both of those events this year. To do so we need a group of volunteers who could plan and assist with putting on the events. The Spaghetti Dinner requires actual cooking, and the Soup Cook-Off involves bringing area restaurants together to show off their best in a fun competition for the "Golden Ladle Award."

Last, but not least, we are looking for persons willing to serve on the OSH Board of Directors. The Board oversees the staff and the financial management and operation of the shelter. The Board meets once a month, on the second Tuesday at 5:30pm. Meetings last about 90 minutes. We are especially in need of a treasurer to oversee financial operations.

If you'd like to help out, but don't have time to volunteer on a regular basis, we always appreciate a homecooked meal, or assistance with home repair projects, or the arrangement of a donation of cleaning items or groceries.

Our Sisters' House is working to make Tomahawk a better place for everyone, but we can't do it all by ourselves. We need the support of our community, and we'd love to have you come out and help us!
