#### Must meet ALL the following Requirements:

#### **Program Requirements:**

- AGE: Must be a young lady 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

  - $\circ$  2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade Halo Division  $\circ$  6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade Niamani Division
  - o 9th to 12th grade I.O.1 Division
- Commitment Contract: Fully completed, and legible commitment contract signed by Parent/Guardian granting child permission to participate
- Report Card: Final Report card from 2022 2023 Year and 1st Semester Report Card from 2023 2024 Year
- Academic Excellence: Must maintain excellence attendance missing no more than 7 days per quarter.
  - Must maintain professional behavior in academic settings, following all school policies, rules, and procedures and must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA or average grades (All Bs, Cs or the equivalent). Academic failures and bad behavior will not be tolerated and is ground for being excluded from the photo shoot and/or show.
  - Members on academic probation must submit midterms or weekly progress sheets demonstrating improvement until permission is granted to do otherwise.

- Financial Obligations: Must meet all the following non-refundable financial obligations and non-negotiated deadlines.

  - \$200 Participation Fee Due by January 17<sup>th</sup> 2024\*

#### **Practice Requirements:**

- Date/Time/Location: Practice on Wednesdays weekly at Hirsch Recreation Complex 3630 Reading Rd, Cincinnati, OH 45229
  - o **Halo** Starting January 17<sup>th</sup> 2024 from 5:30pm to 6:30pm
  - o **Niamani & I.O.1 Beginners** Starting January 17<sup>th</sup> 2024 from 5:30pm to 6:30pm
  - o Niamani & I.O.1 Advanced Starting January 17th 2024 from 6:30pm to 7:30pm
- Practice Attire:
  - o Shoes: Leather bottom shoes & socks are required
    - 6th Grade and Below soft leather bottom shoes with foot fully enclosed
    - 7th Grade and Up leather pumps (at least 2½ inches) with foot fully enclosed
  - Clothing
    - Black pants and Mirror Movement t-shirt (\$15 t-shirts will be on sale at practice);
      - No hoodies, coats, sweaters or sweatshirts should be worn during practice.
      - **NOTE:** If needed can wear a long sleeve shirt under Mirror Movement t-shirt.
  - o Hair: Hair must be pulled away from face for all practices and events unless instructed otherwise.
  - o Eye Glasses: Participants who wear prescription glasses should wear contacts to practice and final performance unless contact lenses are not permitted for medical reasons.
  - o **Prohibited Items:** Oversized jewelry, cell phones, extra bags of any kind, candy, food or drinks are not permitted in the practice area or in the studio.
- Timeliness: Participants are expected to respect the time of the instructor by being on time and being considerate of everyone involved. In the event of late pick-ups by the parents, a \$10 late fee will be charged, and the child will not be able to continue her participation until the fee is paid in full.
  - If a practice is missed, verified excuse is required for extracurricular activities and notification at least 2 days prior;
  - Must attend all activities including but not limited to practices, fittings and rehearsal, to be able to participate in the Fashion
