## CROWN COLONY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION MEETING PROTOCOL AND RECORDING POLICY AND RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Crown Colony Homeowners Association, Inc. (the "Association") is the governing entity for Reserves "C" and "D" of Crown Colony Townhouse, an addition in Harris County, Texas, according to the map or plat thereof, recorded in the Map Records of Harris County, Texas, under Volume 158, Page 69, along with any amendments, supplements, replats, and annexations (collectively referred to as the "Subdivision"), and this Resolution is applicable to the Association and Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Association desires to establish uniform rules and procedures for conducting and recording Member meetings and meetings of the Board of Directors of the Association;

WHEREAS, this Dedicatory Instrument represents Restrictive Covenants as those terms are defined by Texas Property Code §202.001, et. seq., and the Association shall have and may exercise discretionary authority with respect to these Restrictive Covenants;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the foregoing and as evidenced by the Certification hereto. the Association hereby adopts the following with respect to both meetings of members and meetings of the Board of Directors:

- 1. Any video or audio recording of meetings of members or meetings of the Board of Directors shall be prohibited, unless every person in attendance at such meeting consents to such recording.
- 2. Any person attempting to record any meeting without obtaining the consent of all attendees will be requested to leave that meeting.
- 3. In the event a person refuses to cease any unauthorized recording and refuses to leave such meeting, the presiding officer at the meeting shall either adjourn such meeting into executive session or adjourn the meeting in its entirety.
- 4. Any person violating this Policy shall be asked to refrain from bringing any device capable of audio or video recording into any future meeting.
- 5. In the event a person that has previously violated this policy insists on bringing a device capable of audio or video recording into a future meeting, the presiding officer at the meeting may either adjourn such meeting into executive session or adjourn the meeting in its entirety.


