# PROPHECIES OF JESUS FIRST COMING

# AND THEIR FULFILLMENTS

# Prophecy: Messiah would Bruise Satan's Head

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel. *Genesis 3:15 (4000 BC)* 

# **Fulfillment: Jesus Destroyed the Devil**

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he (Jesus) also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; *Hebrews* 2:14 (33 AD)

# Prophecy: Messiah would come From Tribe of Judah

The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh (Messiah) comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people. *Genesis* 49:10 (1689 BC)

#### Fulfillment: Jesus was From the Tribe of Judah

Now Jesus Himself began His ministry at about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, the son of Heli...the son of Matthat, the son of Levi, the son of Melchi, the son of Janna, the son of Joseph, the son of Amminadab, the son of Ram, the son of Hezron, the son of Perez, the son of Judah. *Luke* 3:23-33 (30 AD)

# Prophecy: Messiah would be God Himself

For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. *Isaiah 9:6* (720 BC)

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus was God With Us**

Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. *Matthew 1:23 (0 BC/AD)* 

## **Prophecy: Messiah would Occupy the Throne of David**

Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. *Isaiah* 9:7 (720 BC)

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus was the Son of David**

The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. *Matthew 1:1 (0 BC/AD)* 

#### Prophecy: Messiah would be born in Bethlehem

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting. *Micah* 5:2 (730 BC)

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus was born in Bethlehem**

Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem. *Matthew 2:1 (0 BC/AD)* 

#### Prophecy: Messiah would be born of a Virgin

Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel. *Isaiah* 7:14 (720 BC)

## Fulfillment: Jesus was born of a Virgin

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. *Matthew 1:18 (0 BC/AD)* 

# **Prophecy: Moses Prophesied His Coming**

The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken; *Deuteronomy 18:15 (1450 BC)* 

# Fulfillment: Jesus was "That Prophet"

This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear. *Acts* 7:37 (30 AD)

Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world. *John 6:14 (30 AD)* 

# Prophecy: Messiah would Appear and be Cut Off Before the Destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. *Daniel 9:26 (550 BC)* 

# Fulfillment: Jesus Came and was Crucified Around 33 AD

The Romans then destroyed Jerusalem and the temple in 70 AD.

#### **Prophecy: Messiah would Come Out of Egypt**

When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt. Hosea 11:1 (750 BC)

#### Fulfillment: Jesus was Taken to Egypt and Then Returned

When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son. *Matthew 2:14-15 (2-3 AD)* 

# Prophecy: Messiah would be Rejected

He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. *Isaiah* 53:3 (720 BC)

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus was Rejected**

He came unto his own, and his own received him not. John 1:11 (33 AD)

And they cried out all at once, saying, Away with this man, and release unto us Barabbas. *Luke 23:18 (33 AD)* 

#### Prophecy: Jesus would Ride Upon a Donkey

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. *Zechariah* 9:9 (520 BC)

#### Fulfillment: Jesus' Triumphal Entry was on a Donkey

Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written. *John 12:13-14 (33 AD)* 

# Prophecy: He would be betrayed by a Friend

Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, hath lifted up his heel against me. *Psalm 41:9 (1200 BC)* 

# **Fulfillment: One of Jesus' Own Disciples Betrayed Him**

And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them. *Mark 14:10 (33 AD)* 

#### Prophecy: His Betrayal Price would be 30 Pieces of Silver

And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver. *Zechariah* 11:12 (520 BC)

## Fulfillment: Judas Betrayed Jesus for 30 Pieces of Silver

And said unto them, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver. *Matthew 26:15 (33 AD)* 

# Prophecy: His Betrayal Price Used to Buy a Potter's Field

And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prized at of them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD. *Zechariah 11:13 (520 BC)* 

# Fulfillment: A Potter's Field was Purchased with the Betrayal Money

And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. *Matthew* 27:5-7 (33AD)

# **Prophecy: He would be Beaten With Stripes**

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. *Isaiah 53:5 (720BC)* 

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus was Beaten**

Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified. *Matthew 27:26 (33AD)* 

# **Prophecy: Messiah would Die With the Wicked**

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors. *Isaiah* 53:12 (720BC)

#### **Fulfillment: Jesus Died Between Two Thieves**

Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. *Matthew* 27:38 (33AD)

# Prophecy: Messiah's Hands and Feet would be Pierced

For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet. *Psalm 22:16 (1200BC)* 

## **Fulfillment: Jesus Died by Crucifixion**

Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. *John 20:27 (33AD)* 

#### Prophecy: Messiah would be Given Vinegar to Drink

They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. *Psalm 69:21 (1200BC)* 

#### Fulfillment: On the Cross, Jesus was Given Vinegar to Drink

Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth. *John 19:29 (33AD)* 

# Prophecy: He would be Pierced in the Side with a Spear

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. *Zechariah* 12:10 (520BC)

#### Fulfillment: The Roman Soldiers Stuck a Spear Into Jesus' Side

But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. *John* 19:34 (33AD)

#### **Prophecy: Men would Gamble for His Clothing**

They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture. *Psalm 22:18 (1200BC)* 

## **Fulfillment: The Roman Soldiers Gambled for Jesus' Garments**

And when they had crucified him, they parted his garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take. *Mark 15:24 (33AD)* 

# Prophecy: None of His bones would be Broken

He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken. *Psalm 34:20 (1200BC)* 

# Fulfillment: Jesus' legs were Not Broken

But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs. *John 19:33 (33AD)* 

# Prophecy: He would be Buried With the Rich

And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. *Isaiah* 53:9 (720BC)

#### Fulfillment: Jesus was Buried in a Rich Man's Tomb

When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed. *Matthew* 27:57-60 (33AD)

# Prophecy: He would Resurrect From the Dead

For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. *Psalm* 16:10 (1200BC)

## **Fulfillment: Jesus Rose From the Dead**

And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments: And as they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen. *Luke 24:4-6 (33AD)* 

# Prophecy: Messiah would Ascend Into the Sky

Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them. *Psalm 68:18 (1200BC)* 

# **Fulfillment: Jesus Ascended Up Into the Sky**

And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.  $Acts\ 1:9\ (33AD)$
