

Jesus said the following to the Temple Jews confronting Him ... referring to these ancient Scriptures of Moses at the burning bush

Exodus 3:6 Moreover he said, **I am** the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 3:13-14 And Moses said unto God, Behold, [when] I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What [is] his name? what shall I say unto them? And God said unto Moses, **I AM THAT I AM**: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM** hath sent me unto you.

The following is a compilation of New and Old Testament Scriptures that proclaim the name of Jesus Christ as God's Son, who is also God, our Savior, our Lord and our Creator... I AM

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am

John 5:43 I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive. (Jesus prophecy of the Jews finding a false messiah, the antichrist)

John 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, **I am** the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

John 6:51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

John 8:12 I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

- **John 8:23-24** And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; **I am** from above: ye are of this world; **I am** not of this world. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that **I am** [he], ye shall die in your sins.
- John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.
- **John 10:11 I am** the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: **I am** come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly. **I am** the good shepherd: the good shepherd **giveth his life for the sheep.**
- **John 10:14 I am** the good shepherd, and know my [sheep], and am known of mine.
- **John 10:36** Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, **I am the Son of God**?
- **John 11:25** Jesus said unto her, **I am** the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- **John 12:46 I am** come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- **John 13:13** Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for [so] **I am**.
- **John 14:3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where **I am**, [there] ye may be also.
- **John 14:6** Jesus saith unto him, **I am** the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- **John 15:5 I am** the vine, ye [are] the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.
- **John 18:3-6** Judas then, having received a band of men and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and weapons. Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye? They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, **I am** he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them. As soon then as he had said unto them, **I am** he, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Old Testament

- **Genesis 15:1** After these things the word of the Lord came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: **I am** thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward. (*The first appearance of "I AM" in the Bible*)
- **Genesis 17:1** And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said unto him, **I am** the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

Genesis 26:24 And the Lord appeared unto him the same night, and said, **I am** the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for **I am** with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Genesis 28:13 And, behold, the Lord stood above it, and said, **I am** the Lord God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;

Genesis 28:14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed. (a prophecy of Jesus Christ being born of the seed of Abraham and through Him shall all the world have salvation)

Exodus 6:8 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, **I am** the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments: And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that **I am** the Lord your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage: **I am** the Lord. (Verses 6,7,8 The history of the Israelites are a living picture of the spiritual life of Christians. We are freed from our bondage to sin only to be welcomed into God's abundant life and into the land of milk and honey)
