

SGA Rain Out Policy

- **Complete Washout of Tournament**

If the tournament is cancelled (**See **Supplement** below**) and there are no starts, all players will receive their cost to play in credit from the SGA for a future tournament. In the event it is the last tournament of the season, all players will receive a refund from the SGA.

This tournament may be rescheduled depending upon availability of Golf Course.

Players will be kept informed.

- **Fewer than 9 holes played by all Players**

**** For both Standard Start and Shotgun Start:**

If the tournament begins and **fewer than 9 holes** are completed by all players and the tournament cannot be continued, then the players who started play will be given a rain check for the remaining holes by the golf course and also receive a \$7 credit from the SGA.

Tournament will be cancelled with no payouts!

**** Standard Start only:**

* Players who come to the golf course and do not start play will receive a credit from the SGA for a future tournament. The Golf course will not be paid for the non-starting players.

Tournament will not be rescheduled.

- **All players complete 9 or more holes**

**** For both Standard Start and Shotgun Start**

If all players **complete 9 or more holes**, but all players have not completed **18 holes** and the tournament cannot be continued, then the SGA Board members on-site will determine whether the tournament will be considered a **9-hole or 18-hole tournament** based upon the following criteria:

1. If all players have completed at least **15 holes**, then the SGA will determine the final scoring of that tournament to make it a complete **18-hole tournament** by providing scores for the **missing holes** which equate to a **NET PAR** for each **missing hole**.

2. If fewer than **15 holes** have been completed by all players, then the tournament will be considered a **9-hole tournament**. A 9-hole **Rain Check** will be given by the golf course to all players.

Full payout to players will be made as if it were an 18-hole tournament and all closest to the pin winners on all Par 3's will be valid.

***** For scenarios described above once play is stopped, then within one hour a decision will be made by the on-site SGA board members and announced to the players as to the status of the tournament.**

**** Supplement to the current SGA Rain Out Policy**

If a majority vote decision is made by the SGA board members a day or more before the tournament not to play a scheduled tournament because of inclement weather, then players will be advised not to attend via email. An SGA board member will inform the golf course that the tournament has been canceled. Players will then be able to call the golf course to check the status of the tournament .

If the golf course cancels play before the scheduled tee time on the day of the tournament because of inclement weather, the board members at the course will tell players who are at the course that the tournament is canceled.

If the golf course does not cancel play, then by a majority vote of the on-site SGA board members at the golf course a decision will be made to cancel or play and that decision will be announced to the members at the course at the scheduled start time or within a short interval thereafter.

If it is determined that the tournament is canceled before it is started, then the SGA rain out policy for a *Complete Washout* of the tournament would apply.

If play is begun based on the above, then the remainder of the **Rain out** policy would go into effect.
