

CODE OF CONDUCT

Rehearsals

Stage One rehearsals are held every Friday during school term time, normally between 7.00pm and 9.00pm. Closer to the show there could be extended rehearsals from anytime between 6.30pm until 9.30pm. There will also be some Sunday rehearsals that are usually in the afternoon/early evening at times to fit in with cast availability. Details are always communicated to the cast or are available on the website rehearsal page. Prompt time keeping for rehearsals is required to maximise the available time. During breaks in rehearsals you must remain within the authorised confines of the rehearsal area.

Listen

Listen to what is asked of you and not to talk over any requests. It is a busy environment and listening and paying attention makes for a better rehearsal and for a better show.

Learn

Learn your lines and dance moves that have been shown. They will be required to be practised at home. Don't leave it to the last minute as learning your part and dance moves helps each other.

Respect

Respect at rehearsals is expected at all times. Respect towards each other and to the adults that are there to ensure rehearsals run correctly and safely.

Media

Mobile phones, laptops or devices that may distract you should not be used during rehearsals.

Clothing

Stage One tops should be worn to all rehearsals and performances. This helps people in whatever surroundings we are in identify Stage One members. They should be worn with pride. For dance rehearsal evenings, suitable clothing/footwear should be worn.

Tickets

Once show tickets are released, ticket orders can be placed at rehearsals with the Business Manager or directly from the theatre. The company make more profit if ticket orders are placed through the company. Ticket order forms are available at rehearsals or can be downloaded from the website. Tickets ordered at rehearsals are normally given out at the following rehearsal. As a member you are expected to sell at least twenty five tickets. This will allow the company to cover the cost of putting on the show.

Enjoyment

Enjoyment is what the company want you to get from being a Stage One member. Stage One is run by volunteers who give up their time to be there for you. Commit back to ensure we achieve a good show that everyone will enjoy.
