


I always find it amazing how many friends one makes with complete strangers who love Corvettes!

From the West

For the past few years, I have been attending a Barrett-Jackson Auction (BJA) in either Las Vegas, NV or Scottsdale, AZ.

Las Vegas is a satellite show to the one in Arizona. 663 vehicles crossed the block in Vegas bringing in \$48.2 million dollars. This compares to \$266.7M in Scottsdale. I only spend one day at the shows just looking at the cars; it's a car show for me. Weather was HOT with temperatures 100 plus.



Six of the top ten Chevrolets that crossed the block in Las Vegas this July were Corvettes.

- Lot #733 1963 Chevrolet Corvette 327/360 Z06 Split-window Coupe \$566,500
- Lot #748 1958 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Topless Roadster \$550,000
- Lot #738 1958 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Topless Roadster \$330,000
- Lot #754 1964 Chevrolet Corvette Custom Coupe \$242,000
- Lot #767.1 1967 Chevrolet Corvette 427/435 Convertible \$211,200
- Lot #742 2022 Paul Stanley's Factory Custom Chevrolet Corvette Convertible VIN 001 \$198,000 (Rock Group KISS)

The first three above were in the top 10 non-charity vehicles, with the 63 Split-window second behind the 1970 Plymouth HEMI Superbird that sold for \$1.65 million.

Of note is that 4 of the 6 are "Custom" cars with modifications. Another is that 2 of the top 10 are pickup trucks and the other 2 1969 Camaro and 1956 Bel Air; both customized cars. Following is a link to the BJA article where you can read more about each car.
