

ECIPA 2022 Rule Changes

8,500lb 466 Limited Pro Stock Tractors

- Following 2022 PPL Western Series Rules
- Must use VP Racing Fuels DX diesel fuel only
- Maximum 7100 P-Pump. Maximum barrel and plunger size 13mm
- Recasts heads are allowed.

7,700lb 360 Hot Stock Tractors

- Maximum cubic inch 370. OEM style cylinder heads using factory style intake in factory location and factory style exhaust manifolds, cast iron only. Intake piping not to exceed 4" diameter using only one (1) inlet.
 - Engine decubing allowed for all engine configurations
 - Any engine may be used in any chassis (i.e., IH engine in Deere chassis)
 - Cummins intake shelf must remain on head within factory specs.
 - No deck plates allowed.
 - 12 valve heads only, 2 valves per cylinder.

6,450/6,700lb Light Limited Super Stock Tractors

- 30.5" tires allowed on diesel or alcohol powered tractors, must weight 6,450lbs.
- 24.5x32" tires allowed.
 - Diesel powered tractors may weigh 6,700lbs maximum.
 - Alcohol powered tractors may weigh 6,450lbs maximum.

ECIPA General Rules

- Protest Policy
 - To protest injection pump, a \$500 protest fee is required for tear down of injection pump.
 - Injection Pump Protest: \$300 and \$200 will go to ECIPA Tech.
- Open Speed Safety Rules
 - Protection/Guard required to prevent drivers feet from leaving floorboard/pedal area and coming in contact with rear tires on tractors with cages only.
- Engine Rules > Section 7 > Item C
 - All engines are required to have two (2) 3/8" cables with a minimum of 4 clamps at the splice or crimps with a coupler on each cable. One cable be placed between first and second cylinder through exhaust manifold port area. Second cable around the engine anywhere in the front half of engine. Both cables circle the entire head /block assembly with a maximum of 4" slack.
